1. When is Quick Start?

Quick Start will be held outdoors and students will not enter the school building.

In an effort to minimize on-site time and streamline our process, Quick Start will occur in three parts- two parts online and one part in-person.

Quick Start Part 1 August 17- September 1, 2020 - Online Form Completion

Quick Start Part 3 (September 1 , September 2, September 3-)

Upon completion of Part 1 of the [Quick Start Link](#), students must go to Lane during their scheduled time to take yearbooks photos and pickup other items. The schedule is as follows:

9/1/20- LTAC, Freshmen 9/2/20- Sophomores and Juniors, 9/3/20- Seniors

2. Fees and Payments

School fee payments must be made online through the [Lane Tech EPAY Website](#) . **NEW for 2020-2021** Due to remote learning, several fees have been postponed until we return to in-person learning. However, some fees should be paid now. Please review the Fee Chart Below for more information regarding fees that should be paid now and the ones that may apply once we return to in-person learning. **Please do NOT pay fees that are not required yet.** Everyone **MUST** pay the Standard Fee of **\$400.00** to cover class and activity costs (check the standard fee assessment breakdown sheet for details). If you are taking AP classes, you should also pay for those tests now. Please click [here](#) for more information regarding AP fees and registration for Advanced Placement exams. Additional items must be paid for prior to Quick Start in order to receive the items. **If you are unable to pay the Standard Fee, you can apply for a waiver of instructional fees when completing the Family Income Information Form.** The fee reduction waivers and reductions **ARE NOT** available for additional items. Please review the fee chart below.

3. What if I do not have money to pay for any fees/items?

If a student is unable to pay their fees, the registration process can still be completed and no payment plans are required. Parents can pay for fees throughout the school year through our EPAY website or apply for a waiver for the standard fee when submitting the Family Income Form through the Quick Start registration site.

If families qualify for Free or Reduced Meals using our Family Income Form, the Standard Fee and AP fees will be waived. Do **NOT** pay for the standard fee or AP fees if you have received the waiver in the past and are applying again. You will receive a notification later this winter if you do NOT qualify for the waiver and will be expected to pay at that time. You do not need to make arrangements regarding payments.

Special exceptions must be worked out with a school administrator for families that can only pay for fees using a money order. This approval will not be provided until after August 28th, 2020. 4. Is there a way to reduce the \$400.00 Standard Fee or AP fees?

Yes. The Standard Fee Waiver Reduction Application for the \$400 standard fee must be completed on the Family Income Information Form during the Quick Start process. The Family Income Form is the only way to qualify for a waiver of fees. There are **ONLY** waivers or reductions on Standard Fees and AP Fees. You will need to pay for additional items in full to receive them. If families qualify for Free or Reduced meals, the AP fee will be waived as well. Do NOT pay for the standard fee or AP fees if you have received the waiver in the past and are applying again. You will receive a notification later this fall if you do NOT qualify for the waiver and will be expected to pay at that time. You do not need to make arrangements regarding payments.

5. What if my student is unable to attend in-person Quick Start?

At this time there are no alternative dates to take photos or pickup items. If we are able to set up alternatives, we will inform families at a later date.

6. How long does registration take?

The online process should take less than an hour to complete. The in-person process should take no more than 1.5 hours, but could take longer depending on how many items a student needs to pick up.

7. Do we have to print all forms and return them to the school?

No. We are allowed to collect electronic signatures this year. However, please bring a copy of your immunization records (9th and 10th graders). If that changes, we will let you know.

8. How do I find my account for EPAY?

EPAY is a site separate from your CPS username and password. You can set up an account with EPAY directly or you can use the “ Make a One Time Payment Option”. You will need your student ID for both options.

9. How much are the Quick Start fees?

Quick Start fees are determined by the needs of your child. Every student must pay a standard fee of **\$400.00 unless they qualify for the waiver..** Several fees have been postponed due to remote learning, but certain fees should still be paid for before remote learning. If we return to in-person learning, additional fees may be expected.

15. What is the SAT Prep Fee and what are the benefits of it, and also do you need to pay it during Quick Start or is it delayed until in-person learning starts?

Please do not pay this fee at this time. We will inform families if we will resume SAT Prep courses.

16. How do I know what to pay?

all students should pay the standard Fee. Please refer to your courses to determine what you should pay. For example, if you have a Music class and an AP (Non-Capstone), then you would pay the fee for the standard fee, Music Fee, and an aP Capstone Fee.
