#### **General Information**

The fifteenth annual Community Changers Mission Camp will be conducted June 15<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at Mechanicsville Baptist Church. Reporting time and location for all campers will be at 3:00-5:00pm, Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, at the multi-purpose building (South side of Hwy 34 across from the old church). All campers will sign in at the front entrance no later than 5:00pm. The first meal will be served at 6:00pm. The remaining time on Sunday will be directed toward settling in, getting oriented and acquainted. Lights out at 10:30pm. The schedule of daily activities is in accordance with the enclosed schedule.

Work crews will be organized to meet work requirements and provide opportunities to meet and work with new people most effectively. Considering these objectives, once assignments are made, requests for reassignment should be avoided. Crew assignments will be provided early after sign-in on June 15<sup>th</sup>.

Campers should arrive for sign-in with a five-day supply of clothing, personal hygiene items and bedding in accordance with the enclosed packing list. Note: Individual bunks with mattresses will be provided. Campers must bring linens and blankets as needed. Sleeping bags may be substituted for linens and blankets. Pillows will not be provided if required bring your own. Clothing selection must consider that campers are representing their church and that the work environment may be harsh. Shorts, Tee shirts (NO Short Shorts or Tank tops), and head cover is appropriate. Campers should have available long pants (jeans, etc.) in the event of work environment requirement.

All use of personal electronic devices (telephone, games, music) will be strictly limited to personal time as reflected on the daily schedule. **This procedure will be enforced!** 

The daily schedule allows personal time each day to meet individual needs. Lights out will be at 10:30 pm each evening. Campers should be ready for bed at that time all activity should cease.

Medical concerns while at the base camp will be brought to the attention of the Camp Nurse. Medical concerns on work sites will be brought to the attention of the Team Leader. Campers bringing medication must bring them in the original prescription containers with label instructions. All medication will be cleared through the camp nurse during in-processing. Emergencies will be evacuated to the nearest emergency room.

The fee for participants, campers and support personnel, is \$75 per person. This fee covers food cost for five days. All checks should be made payable to Mechanicsville Baptist Church (Note Community Changers on the bottom).

Applications and registration fees should be consolidated at local churches and forwarded to: Director, MBC Community Changers. All youth applicants will complete the Registration form, The Parental / Guardian Permission/ Release, and the Mission Covenant forms as enclosed and marked <u>"For Return With Application"</u>. Adult participants (anyone 18 years old and over) will complete the Adult Registration Form only. Applications will be accepted starting now and through June 8<sup>th</sup>.

Project submissions / recommendations will be accepted starting now until June 1st.
