Rules:

Now about those ingredients.. You will choose a heavy fighter filled with bravery and skill on the battlefield (Or not)! You must watch your fighter during the first scenario and (hopefully) encourage them to defeat their enemies with honor, and with the knowledge that every time he/she dies you are left with fewer ingredients. You will be in charge of tracking your fighter's deaths. The cook with the fighter who has had the least amount of deaths will get the first bag (with the best ingredients) and the cook with the fighter who has had the most amount of deaths will get the last bag (with ingredients gathered by a rabid yak). You will be judged on tastiness-the Yum Factor, the heartiness-how filling is it?, and volume (you are cooking for a siege afterall)

Championships:

Please note all tournaments will run no longer than 1.5 hours with exception of Archery and A & S Judging. All competitors for the Championship are required to join the Champions Processional and name a consort on Saturday morning. Heraldic display and an introduction are encouraged.

Bardic

Preferred if entrants sign up beforehand. Single performance each and strongly preferred that they have either a celtic theme or that it links with the Barony's history. Judging will be done by the Baron and Baroness and the current champion.

Heavy

All entrants will fight with sword and board in a round robin tourney until there are two finalists. Those finalists will be our "champions" and will lead the two sides of the heavy war on Sunday. As one of the champions, you must gather your forces for the war. You must also meet head to

head and boast about your prowess and honor. You must prove you are worthy to be the champion. If you can lead your side to victory, you will prove that your honor, skill, and prowess are indeed great enough to make you the Baronial Heavy Fighting Champion.

(An honorable champion would not attempt to overpower the other side with numbers, and would instead attempt to make the sides as even as possible; thereby proving their worth through skill. Bribes will be made to even the sides if it is not done by the champions.)

Rapier

Pirate Pit: Small ring of crazy shenanigans. No restrictions.
