

# Positive Coaching Alliance/Triple-Impact Competitor Scholarships

**Deadline: May 31, 2017**

Positive Coaching Alliance/Triple-Impact Competitor awards scholarships of \$1,000-\$2,000 (depending on location) to high school athletes, based on their essays explaining how they meet the standard defined in *Elevating Your Game*.

A Triple-Impact Competitor makes positive contributions on three levels:

1. Makes oneself better (Personal Mastery);
2. Makes teammates better (Leadership); and
3. Makes the sport better (Honoring the Game).

## Eligibility:

- Current High School Junior (class of 2018)
- Grade Point Average of 2.5 or above
- Current resident of the United States of America
- Participant in individual or team sport sponsored by school or local club

## A completed application comprises:

- Triple-Impact Competitor Scholarship Application
- One testimonial from a school administrator (athletic director, teacher, counselor, etc.)
- One testimonial from a coach
- At least one testimonial (and up to three) by individuals who are familiar with the student-athlete and able to speak to his/her embodiment of the Triple-Impact Competitor principles (for example fellow teammates, competitors, referees etc.)

## Selection and Notification:

All 2017 scholarship finalists will be notified via email in August of 2017 and the full list will be posted on PCA's website. Scholarship winners will be announced at the local awards events in the fall/winter of 2017. Winners of the 2016 Triple-Impact Competitor Scholarship will be announced on a chapter basis throughout the winter and spring of 2017.

## **Application Period:**

The application period for 2017 awards runs from January 1, 2017 through May 31, 2017. Applications can only be submitted online. If you have any problems, please e-mail Program Administrator Jennie Wulbrun.

Eligibility extends to any high school junior residing anywhere in the U.S. and playing for a high school team or in club sports!

## The Iranian Scholarship Foundation

**Deadline: May 31, 2017**

**Eligibility:** The Iranian Scholarship Foundation (ISF) was founded in 2000 by Mrs. Azadeh Hariri, with the vision of creating an effective scholarship program for Iranian-American students in the United States. Mrs. Hariri's vision also included a desire to ensure that the second generation of Iranians coming of age in the United States retain their Iranian heritage, while at the same time adjusting competently to American society, by being the best and brightest students, and eventually arriving in skilled, decision-making positions where they can influence not only Iranian Americans, but the greater public's perception of them.

**1- Dr. Ali Jarrahi Merit Scholarship:** Be of Iranian descent Be enrolled or accepted one of the top universities in the United States Possess and maintain a GPA of 4.0 or higher Have a portfolio of community service Have a minimum SAT score of 2000 or ACT score of 30 Award: \$2,000.

**2- Excellence in Community Service Scholarship:** Be of Iranian descent Be enrolled or accepted at a four-year accredited university in the United States Possess and maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher Have a portfolio of community service Have a minimum SAT score of 1850 or 27 for ACT (if applying as a high school student) Award: varies

**3- ISF Undergraduate Scholarship Deadline:** Undergraduates only, no graduate student scholarships are available at this time. Be of Iranian descent Be enrolled or accepted at a four-year accredited university in the United States Demonstrate Financial need Possess and maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher Have participated in community service and continue to do so Have a minimum SAT score of 1850 or 27 for ACT (if applying as a high school student) Award: varies
