The code of conduct is fundamental to upholding our club's core values and developing our culture of respect and inclusion that has defined us over the years.

Our Core Values & Beliefs - Our players, families and coaches aspire to:

- Demonstrate integrity, respect, antiracism, inclusivity of all races, genders, identities, sexual orientations, and religions, equity and sportsmanship in all we do.
 - Instill a lifelong love of the game.
 - Build a strong sense of community among all our stakeholders.
 - Take a "whole life," player centric perspective in all our decisions.
 - Develop all players, regardless of skill level, to their full soccer potential.

When I am attending any Club event, I promise to:

- 1) Treat ALL players, coaches, referees, and spectators with respect. Specifically, actions that promote antiracism, diversity, equity, inclusion, and good sportsmanship.
- 2) Follow ALL rules established by my Player's coach and/or the Club.
- 3) Refrain from coaching ANY player, including MY Player.
- 4) Refrain from criticizing or abusing ANY referee or other game official.
- 5) Refrain from criticizing or abusing ANY player, coach, or spectator from MY team and/or opposing team.
- 6) Act at all times in a manner that reflects positively on me, my Player, my Player's team, and the Seattle United community.
