Summary of the Executive Committee Meeting - 2

August 2, 2025, Springfield, VA

Present: Dr. M. Rafiq Chaudhry, Ijaz Ahmad Malik, Dr. Bashir Aslam Qasmi, Dr. M. Athar, Dr. Ghulam Sarwar (via Zoom) & Dr. Fallak Sher Sial (Chaired by Dr. Bashir Aslam Qasmi)

- 1. Dr. Azeem Iqbal Khan, Chairman PBG, will be the focal person at UAF.
- 2. Fund raising has been dissatisfactory so far. Therefore, it was decided that a fresh request will be sent to all the members of UAFAANA (including those who left the WhatsApp for some reason) to contribute at least \$300 each and the members will be followed with personal reminders, and provided with Tax-deductible invoices.
- 3. Primarily ten (10) scholarships at Rs. 8,500/month per student will be awarded in five faculties viz. Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Science, Agri Engineering and Technology and Social Sciences (Economics and Rural Sociology). Number of scholarships per faculty will be decided by Dr. Azeem depending upon the number of students per faculty and his judgement. One-year amount will be transferred to the University every year.
- 4. Dr. Fallak Sial will be the Contact person from UAFAANA to correspond with the UAF.
- 5. The current list of members on the web page will be replaced with the list with Dr. Rafiq. This list will include even those alumni who have left the WhatsApp group. For this purpose, additional column in the database will be included showing status regarding WhatsApp group membership.
- 6. The alumni who have left the WhatsApp group will be approached by Dr. Rafiq to donate \$300 per person and rejoin the WhatsApp group.

- 7. All the documents will be displayed on UAFAANA's webpage only and at the moment, will not use Facebook, X, LinkedIn and other social media platforms.
- 8. In line with the decision already made, no joint efforts will be sought with any other association doing similar work as UAFAANA.
- 9. Dr. Sarwar will contact with the members living in the West coast (California and surroundings) and encourage them to contribute as much as they can. Same is the case with Dr. Qasmi who will take up the similar responsibility for Texas and surrounding areas after moving there.
