Academic Testing Overview

Typical standardized testing timeline:

<u>PSAT (Preliminary SAT)</u>- taken in October of grade 10 and 11 (optional and administered at ECHS)

 An inexpensive practice version of the SAT in a timed setting that projects future SAT scores. Junior scores may be used to qualify for National Merit Scholarships.

AP (Advanced Placement)- taken in May of the year the student is enrolled in the corresponding AP course (optional and administered at ECHS)

• Students who score a 3,4, or 5 on the exam may earn college credit at the university they eventually matriculate to.

<u>SAT</u> or <u>ACT</u>- typically taken the spring of grade 11 and/or fall of grade 12 (optional and taken off-site)

- Comparison of the two tests
- <u>Khan Academy</u> and <u>ACT Academy</u> both offer free online test personalized test practice.

CAASP- taken the spring of grade 11 (required and administered at ECHS)

 Can be used to determine English and Math placement at California Community Colleges and universities in the California State University system.
