1. Go to the Random Hint Button
2. Click Options
3. Select "5 a day, record attachment, easy (or desired level of difficulty)."
4. Close with X in right top corner
5. Select the # of hints you want and click the Quick Hint button

Temple Enhancement Message: Temple Dedications and The Hosanna Shout

Family History Skill: The Improved Merge Experience in FamilySearch.

Why is cleaning up the family tree in FamilySearch important? How do I identify duplicate profiles and merge them? How does this process improve temple work?

Note: When merging information from two differing profiles the second column will be the dominant profile and ID number that survives. If you feel that the first profile is more accurate or should survive you may click the switch button (Occasionally FamilySearch will tell you that the profiles may be merged, but that they have to be done in a certain order and cannot be switched.).

Information and records from both profiles will be combined to the third column and that will be the new merged file. If information from the two files conflicts, the default is to choose the information from column two to survive. If, however, when there is a conflict, some information in column one is the better information, you may click the circle in front of that information to survive.
