Important Reminders

- Our school day begins at 8:25 AM and ends at 2:55 PM, 1:45 on Wednesdays.
- If your child arrives after 8:25 AM you must sign them into the main office.
- Remember that students should not be congregating outside of the building in the mornings before the 8:15 bell. Students should remain in vehicles until allowed entry at 8:15. Students will not be allowed access before 8:15 unless they are eating breakfast.
- Please pick up your child on time! All students must be picked up by 2:55, and 1:45 on Wednesdays, unless they are attending an after school event.
- Parents of walkers, please remind your students about following the campus rules and about being safe on their walks to and from school.
- Parents of car riders, please pay attention to the directions and instructions of the staff members outside during pick-up/drop-off times. Grade Level Spotlight!

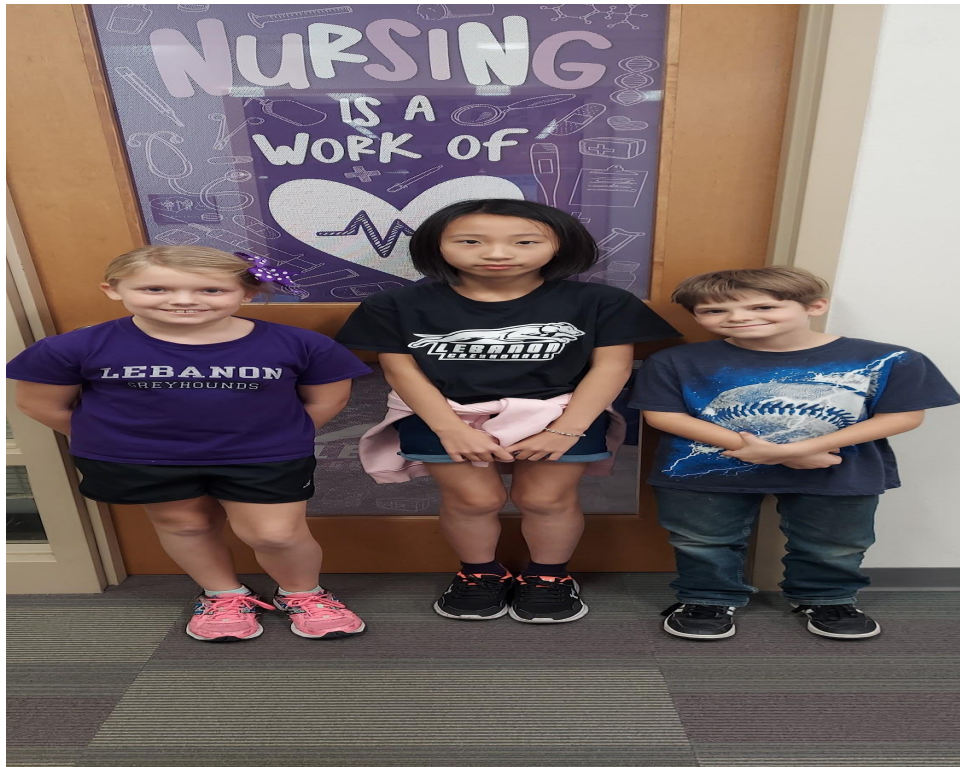
4th Grade
