## 1:45 p.m. Morning Work Group Share Outs (15)

From the Al Policy and Title II groups that met virtually and in-person, respectively:

• Al Policy – We are not sure there is a need for a specific Al Policy at this time. Many issues, such as academic integrity or intellectual property, are addressed in those respective policy statements and would be redundant in any Al/technology specific policy. We're suggesting a functional approach to policy as opposed to policy addressing specific technology. Perhaps the deliverable is a review of current policy or sample syllabi statements. We get a sense there might be a greater need for teaching and learning at this time? Perhaps sharable canvas modules or lessons?

We recognize that many of our tools have embedded AI and have for years. Colleges are addressing the AI issue at various levels with some college presidents initiating programs and some colleges are evolving an approach from front line employees. For example, Edmonds president supported the development of an AI Learning Hub for the wider Snohomish County community to learn about the tools. As has occurred at other campuses Edmonds developed sample Syllabi statements, campus learning sessions, and an AI learning module was incorporated in the college first year experience course.

We know other councils have AI interest- or working groups, eg, eLC. LLC liaisons might look for common areas of interest and synergies for future collaboration.
