

AUSTRALIAN GREENS NATIONAL CONFERENCE - November 2024

COVID SAFETY INFORMATION

We want everyone attending Conference in person to be safe, especially those at a higher risk of serious consequences should they contract COVID-19. Because of this, we are implementing the following measures relating to COVID safety and accessibility to protect people who attend.

- Attendees will be expected to wear masks at the conference, and masks will be readily available for people should they require them.
- ▲ We are working with volunteers and presenters to ensure they are aware of accessibility requirements, including COVID safety, movement through the venue, and online experience.
- ▲ Attendees are strongly encouraged to use N95/P2 masks if it is safe and accessible for them to do so.



- ▲ Anyone attending in person is strongly encouraged to have their most recent vaccination if it is safe for them to do so.
- Anyone attending in person is strongly encouraged to do a RAT before travelling to the venue. There will be RATs available for people to use over the weekend should they need them.
- ▲ People should not attend the conference in person if they are unwell or symptomatic in any way, or if they have tested positive to COVID-19 within the last seven days. If you are able, you can attend the conference online.
- ▲ We have food serving protocols in place, including early access to meals for people who are immunocompromised or disabled, and there will be volunteers serving food to attendees to reduce the handling of implements.
- ▲ We have technology and equipment to ensure the people attending online have a great experience that is as professional and streamlined as it can be.
