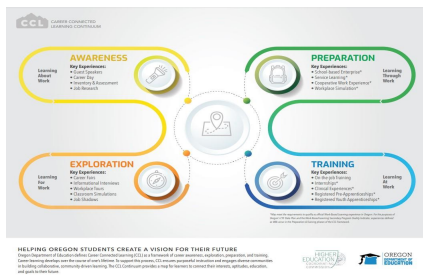
Professional Learning Series
