Aims and objectives

The aim of this round of research is to understand more about the reasons why people who book other spaces do not use community halls.

Research aims to explore

- Their experiences of booking spaces for hire
- What factors influence their decisions to book (E.g. cost, facilities, venue provider, locality, personal connections etc)
- Their motivations and barriers to booking venues for their event(s)
- What do non-bookers think about the community halls
- What we could do to improve our services and attract more users

- Reason(s) for hiring space
- How often spaces are needed
 - One off vs regular use
- Times spaces are needed

Where do you normally book for your events?

- Why did you pick that space?
 - Size, facilities, cost, location, quality of the venue, etc
 - Reputation of the provider

Where did you first find out about the space?

- Search online?
- Venue provider website? E.g. https://hirespace.com
- Saw an advertisement?
- Word of mouth/personal contact?
 - o How was that?
 - Were you able to find everything you wanted first time?

Do you know about community halls available for hire?

[If Yes] Could I ask the reason why you choose not to book a community hall?

- Size (not big enough/too big what size would you want?)
- Facilities (need things like WiFi, sound systems etc if halls had that, would you use them?)
- Cost/payment (too expensive, terms of payment not flexible, have to pay a deposit/deposit too much - what could we change to make it more attractive? Would that be enough to book a space?)
- Location
- Quality of the venue, etc
- Reputation of the provider

- Face to face show them the community halls booklet (could also ask them to compare the halls with their chosen venue)
- Over the phone, read out: XXXX
