## **Topic: Greece's Moria Refugee Camp**

The refugee camp named Moria is found on the island in Lesbose, Greece. This camp was created in the year 2013, and holds mainly Syrian, Afghan and Somalian immigrants. in addition, there are less populated people there from other cultures. As of the summer of 2020 camp Moria is known to hold approximately 17,000 to 20,000 fleeing refugees (international/archive/2019/11/greeces-moria).

The refugees from camp Moria fled from their home countries due to economic and social problems; such as wars, street violence, evacuation from damaged property, and poverty. Currently, there are many children still living in camp Moria, including minors who are facing horrible conditions on a daily basis. As a result, many children have and continue to experience trauma, exhibited by signs of depression. Caused by the fact that the conditions in Moria camp are inhumane. For example, they have no clean water due to the lack of a proper water filtration system. Overcrowding has also caused hygienic issues allowing people to easily spread infectious diseases. Also, the limited capacity for space causes conflict between the refugies, as it is very uncomfortable to live in such close proximity to others. These conditions as well do not provide a healthy or safe space for any official educational system to thrive, and electrical issues, further contribute to the difficulty of children receiving a proper education. Lastly, supplies are short and some that are needed for human survival are not prevailing. However Despite the circumstances these refugees are in, it is better that they got together and made camp Moria than nothing at all.
