Dress Code

The purpose of a dress code is to provide an environment that is conducive to learning and mutual respect. We want our students to be able to express their individual styles while maintaining focus on learning and academics.

The following attire is prohibited:

- 1. Any shirt or garment referring to sex, drugs, alcohol, violence, gangs, reference to weapons, or containing degrading/harassing statements.
- 2. Any exposed undergarments or see-through clothing or excessive skin exposure including but not limited to midriff skin, cleavage or back.
- 3. Any headwear not for religious purposes, including, but not limited to, hats, visors, bandannas, sweatbands, sunglasses, etc... <u>Hoods of hooded sweatshirts may **NOT** cover the head for safety purposes.</u> All students should be identifiable at all times.
- 4. Sleepwear or **costume** clothing/shoes/accessories.
- 5. Any item including jewelry or ornamentation that could be a safety hazard and have potential to cause bodily harm.
