NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to any boat of any class. If you are not one of the designs listed in the start times, please email communications@westriversc.com to get a start time.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 Entry is free for any West River Sailing Club Member.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 June 27 1200 Competitors' Meeting

5 STARTS (MUST READ!)

- 5.1 Starts will use the Pursuit Method of starting. Listed below is the exact start time and in parentheses, the countdown time from the prep signal is listed.

- 5.2 Prep signal will be at 1255:00

- 5.4 OCS PENALTY: If a boat is OCS and does not clear their penalty, they will be charged a 30-minute or 35-minute penalty for the Short and Long Course, respectively.

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6 FINISHING & SCORING

- 6.1 Finishes will be recorded in the order that they cross the line, regardless of fleet. Scoring will be complete overall as well as one-design.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 There are two courses, Short Course and Long Course, as described below. Course decision will be made at the Competitor's Meeting.

Short Course:

- The Short Course will have the start and finish line between the WRSC Burgee on the dock and a hippity-hop on the water.
- Round to port the second hippity-hop south of the starting line.
- Round Flat Island, Skippers Choice of rounding direction.
- Round to starboard the hippity-hop south of the starting line.
- Finish.

Long Course:

- The Long Course will have the start and finish line between the WRSC Burgee on the dock and a hippity-hop on the water.
- Round to port the second hippity-hop south of the starting line.
- Round Flat Island, Skippers Choice of rounding direction.
- Round the "G" mark from Tuesday/Wednesday Nights, Skippers Choice of rounding direction.
- It is Skippers Choice as to which, Flat Island or "G" Mark, they round first.
- Round to starboard the hippity-hop south of the starting line.
- Finish.

- 7.2 All competitors must pass all channel markers and Tuesday/Wednesday Night markers on the channel side.

- 7.3 A detailed charted course will be posted on the notice board on the eastern window.
