Here's how to make your custom URL. On your profile page, click <b>Edit public profile &amp; URL</b> on the right. Under <b>Edit your custom URL</b> on the right side, click the <b>pencil</b> next to your URL. Type or edit the last part of your new custom URL in the text box. It's recommended to use a variation of your name or professional brand. When you're done, click <b>Save</b> .
