I would like to say a big thank you to the club reps for their time and effort in getting scores in. As this was my first season running the competition and also the first year of the brand new scoring and results system, we were all learning as we went along. That said, though, feedback has been positive and hopefully, I'll continue to run the competition in the same manner next indoor season.

The numbers of archers participating this year has been very good with boosts to both seniors and juniors over last year. We have almost had a return to pre-lockdown numbers, which is encouraging. It has been good to see the increase in the number of juniors shooting as last season was a record low. There were very good numbers of archers shooting the competition for the first time with over 90 new archers taking part.

Three all time records were broken:

Senior Female Barebow was improved from 244 to 275 by Anastasia Wilson of the Foxes Senior Male Compound was improved from 295 to 297 by Adam Ravenscroft of the Foxes Senior Male Flatbow was improved from 199 to 219 by Yusuf Dalal of Leicester Academy

One new record was set for the first time: Junior Female Flatbow was set at 90 by Lucianne Faulkner of LAOFAC
