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
Hello AP Student,

I know there is a lot of information coming your way regarding your AP Exams. Please know that your teacher and myself are here to help you with any questions you may have during this time.

I am including some important information from College Board to help guide you through the AP Exam day experience. Please note that payment for fees is due at this time if this has not been taken care of yet. Your AP exam fee has been placed on your account in Skyward for payment in RevTrack. You will not be able to test if your fee has not been paid.

Coming Soon:

AP Exam Demo: On **May 4**, you'll be able to practice submissions through the exam demo, which will give you click-through practice for the different ways to submit your responses to this year's AP Exams. We encourage all students to take this important preparation step to avoid technical difficulties on exam day. The demo will be generic across subjects, and not a practice exam.

AP Prep Week: Next week, the online <u>AP Classes and Review Sessions</u> will focus on the exam day experience and sample exam questions.

Two Days Before Exams: You'll receive an email with your exam e-ticket 48 hours before your exam.

Portfolio Submissions Due: AP Computer Science Principles submissions are due by May 26, 10:59 p.m. Check with Mr. Mustain if you are having any issues with this.

If you haven't already, please talk to your family about your needs on exam day. It is important that others not use the internet on that day while you are testing and that you are not interrupted.

I want to applaud you all for keeping up the hard work and diligence as you prepare to test. Like many other things you are faced with these days, you are asked to complete your exams in a very different manner than you thought you would when you registered for your course(s). I admire your tenacity and know you will ROCK your exams!!!!!
