Singapore Math Dimensions

The Singapore math method is focused on mastery with concepts being built upon in each level. It teaches students the how and why of math with intentional sequencing of concepts involving students returning to topics over the course of years, each time building complexity and depth. Students are introduced to problem variation at an early stage. Instead of pushing through rote memorization, they are asked to think creatively and mathematically, relying on knowledge gained in previous lessons and trying new techniques. In Singapore math, students must think through concepts and apply them in new ways from the very start.

Singapore math not only helps students become more successful problem solvers, it helps them gain a sense of confidence and resourcefulness because it insists on conceptual depth. Some of the key features of the approach include the CPA (Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract) progression, number bonds, bar modeling, and mental math.

Throughout the textbook are engaging illustrations, chapter summaries, and pronunciation for science vocabulary.

Student pages include a study notebook with fun activities to go with each chapter and hands-on labs that correlate with specific chapters. Some of the activity pages require students to cut and glue to make a book with manila file folders. Teacher pages include lesson plans, mid-term and final quizzes, and answers to the student notebook. The lesson plans do not include a day-by-day schedule but are intended to be a flexible weekly record sheet to create a nice portfolio of your student's work.
