



Open Studio Sessions at RDP are open-access workshop hours in our studio on Allison Street. The sessions centre on our practical resources and how they can be utilised to support an artist-led publishing practice. We welcome you to drop into Rosie's to test print ideas for free!

Open Studios IS:

- A space to test print a few copies of a new publication
- Time to experiment with equipment
- An informal space to gather with other artists with shared interests in artist-led publishing

Open studios IS NOT:

- For printing a full run of pamphlets/ books
- An in-depth/formal editing session
- For pitching work to Rosie's

Capacity: Rosie's studio space is very small, and has a capacity of 6 people. As we trial this open print drop in we are choosing not to require bookings to attend. This may mean you might need to wait awhile before you are able to print your files. We will have tea/coffee and light refreshments available, and a space to sit down. We haven't run this kind of drop-in before therefore we are yet to gauge how busy the space may be. We will adjust future formats based on how the first session runs.

How to bring your files:

- Please either email your files to studio@rosiesdisobedient.press
- OR bring your laptop and we will have USB sticks/ dongles available.

We will have our desktop computer available for printing, and one of Rosie's team can support you in sending files to the printer. We have access to Adobe Creative Cloud for arranging and preparing

files. Prior knowledge of this software is required as we can only support, but not prepare full files for you.

Printing Specs:

- Printing (max 60 pages per person)
- A4 & A3
- Ability to print double-sided
- Scan/ Photocopy functions up to A3
- Black & White and Colour Printing
- Paper in a range of thicknesses for interior and exterior prints

Additional Studio Facilities

- Staple binding
- Bone finders
- Cutting mats
- Stanley knives
- Bookbinding needles, tailor's awl and linen thread
- Electric Guillotine (can cut up to A3)

Where we're based:

We have a small studio as part of Broadside Studios located at 123 Allison Street in Govanhill. The studio is 4 minutes walk from Queens Park Train Station and between 2 bus routes which go to the city centre. On-street parking is available in the streets surrounding the studio.
