ii. Things that do not pertain to us were cut out

iii. Under G(i) changed to pertain to YHALE; G(ii) provides time period for parent's request for information (within 30 days)- legislature did not want school to be disrupted.

Language is pretty broad, so it wasn't changed.

iv. Policy is more specifically spelled out later through the Bill of Rights.

v. Policies to promote parental involvement already in existence listed in the Bill of Rights

vi. Policies and Procedures relating to the Parents' Bill of Rights are changed to relate to YHALE (i.e., no option of appealing to "superintendent")

vii. Requests and time periods to respond are specified to a reasonable amount of time (two-week time period)

viii. Objections to instructional materials are specified to include discussion between the principle and the parent to clarify the objection

ix. Permission to take photographs, videos, voice recordings, etc. – YHALE already has this within its enrollment packet. Added in "Parents can write in to change their permission decision to allow or to deny YHALE to take photographs or video or voice recordings of his or her child may do so by requesting in writing, preferably by email to the data clerk, a blank permission form" most recent dated form will be what YHALE goes by
