*I shall assist in establishing a structure and an environment designed to ensure all students have the opportunity to attain their maximum potential through a sound organizational framework;*

*I shall strive to ensure a continuous assessment of student achievement and all conditions affecting the education of our children, in compliance with State law;*

*I shall serve as education's key advocate on behalf of students and our community's schools to advance the vision for Lake Forest Community High School District 115; and*

*I shall strive to work together with the District Superintendent to lead the School District toward fulfilling the vision the Board has created, fostering excellence for every student in the areas of academic skills, knowledge, citizenship, and personal development.*
