Age: 16 when they run away from home with their sister, Lois. 17 when they take up various odd jobs to provide for them and Lois. 18 when they say "fuck it" and make most of their money through various means of swindling, thievery, and seduction aimed towards gullible rich sugar daddies. 19 when their life as an adventurer properly begins. 23 at World Wakes. In their early 30s Currently.

Date Of Birth: Wintumber 7th, Year 146 of the 5th age

Gender: Nonbinary (They/Them)

Sexuality: Pansexual

Summarized Backstory

Morgan was born in East Ardougne to a relatively well off family. A lot of their childhood was spent being forced to hang out with fakeass ppl that they didnt give two shits about, and the rest of it was spent making a name for themself as the Town Lunatic by pulling pranks, stealing shit, spreading conspiracies about the plague next door, you name it. Their parents were not Abusive, but they certainly werent Good parents by any means, and it kinda messed morgan up a bit.

They run off to pursue adventuring after an argument with their mom thats started over a botched haircut. They hide in the sewers to sulk, end up spying on the hazeel cult, and realize, oh shit, theres more cool stuff out there in the world, huh? So they run away, their sister follows them by her own will, and the two of them begin new lives out there! By that i mean, lois becomes the princess of miscellania, and morgan becomes a Bitch— i mean, a world guardian!

Physical Profile

Height: They'll say that they're 5'6", but they're actually 5'5". It only makes a big difference to them and absolutely no one else.

Hair: Naturally brunette, dyed **red** at 17, but they decide that's not the best look for them, so they try **purple** at 19. That works enough for them to keep it that way for several years. Then at some point (after Fate of the Gods) they dye it **teal**, or is it **aquamarine**? They seemingly do this for no reason at all. They let the color fade to **bleach blonde** after Kindred Spirits. After Endgame, their hair is dyed **jet black**. Through all the changes, the sides of their head are shaved, their hair is styled into a mohawk, with sideburn tufts grown out by their ears.

Eyes: Amber/Hazel. Sometimes gold in the right light!

Face: Traditional anglo features. Blend of Soft and Sharp. Pointed chin for a diamond shaped head, pointed, sharp nose, a bit of softness on their cheeks. Catlike eyes. Their eyebrows are shaved off entirely, and drawn on. Their eyeliner is almost always done up heavily at all times.

Body: Pale skin. Svelte with some muscle definition. A bit of a cinched waist, but not enough to lean entirely feminine. Flat chested, they have Some tiddy, but it's barely there.

Piercings: Six ear piercings in total, three for each ear. Their earlobes are gauged, and they have two outer conch piercings on each ear that's either left empty, occupied by helixes, or industrials.

Scars: Aside from battle scars, (TW: SELF HARM MENTION) [REDACTED]

Voice: [Catra](#) from She-Ra is a good fit, but I'm leaning towards something like [this character](#) because they're voiced by a trans person, and trans people should get to play trans characters! I guess a mix of both voices would be cool? I love how angry Catra is.

Outfits

Battle: Black armor that they stole off of random black knights because they thought it looked cool. Modified with gold trim. They're not officially affiliated with kinshra in any way, they just wear the armor to put off Saradominist extremists, because they want nothing to do with them if they're gonna judge their character based solely on looks anyway. They also wear a torn red cape.

Casual: Black shirt, bandages to cover up scars, harnesses worn to carry weapons and tools, chest harness is secured with a pin in the shape of Saradomin's four pointed star, not out of faith, but as a keepsake from the life they abandoned. (They later put aside this symbol in favor of Zamorakian or Zarosian ones.) Brown pants with thigh high boots. They ALWAYS wear a bandana around their neck. Sometimes they wear a poncho, like a cowboy. Later on they will sometimes accessorize with Nabanik's old trilby.

Weapon: 2 black swords. Quick and lightweight, but deadly. They're also pretty decent with long range weapons, but they're weak with magic for the longest time, but with a lot of practice they're a force to be reckoned with, especially with fire spells. They prefer melee overall because they find it easiest to punch their way through their problems.

Personality

Can easily be described as Punk Rock, Anarchist. Morgan is both difficult and easy to read, because they can be an entirely different person depending on who they're interacting with. But at the end of the day, these are the qualities that shine through, no matter what situation they're in. Reckless, hedonistic, daring, nihilistic, and vengeful. They've been hurt and they want Everyone to pay for it, but they want Themselves to pay for it the most, if that makes any sense?

Aura: Pure, blind rage, comparable to the bloodlust of the late Bandos, equatable to Zamorak's ruthless, scourge-like demeanor on the battlefield. This is a part of them they tend to keep under reserve, which is saying a lot, because they're Always an angry little bitch by default, how much worse could they possibly get? (A lot worse, that's the answer!) They've been told that they have a Dragon's soul. Fiery, wild, and defiant. They can tough it out in the worst of fights, and instill fear in the hearts of their enemies. This isn't guaranteed OP powers though, because their lack of self discipline and crippling self loathing makes this part of them hard to harness for good purposes, if anything it just comes out on accident at the most inopportune times. Overall, they command fear, not respect. Because they never needed respect.

Strengths: This might count as a strength; they truly do not give a fuck. Who cares how much they get injured? As long as they get the job done, it doesn't matter what happens to their physical form. They've already done enough damage to it, what's a little more gonna do, really? But as far as actual strengths go, they're loud and assertive...? Wait, those could be weaknesses too. They can use their seduction as a weapon, and they're an incredibly skilled thief, almost rivaling Ozan. They also care SO MUCH about the people close to them (which I guess, in some circumstances, could also be a weakness. DAMMIT MORGAN.) They're literally still existing just to make sure their sister can have a decent life of their own, and then after that, the jury's out. They'll probably wanna go out with a bang.

Weaknesses: Half the stuff I mentioned above is already a weakness. On top of that, they're hedonistic. They don't make decisions based on what's best in the long term, they just go with how they feel, and usually they feel Very Chaotic. The reason for this behavior is that they never really saw a Long Term for themselves. They didn't think they'd live past 18, (TW: SUICIDE MENTION) But despite all odds, they're still existing. And they spend that existence partaking in illicit substances, pleasure seeking activities, dangerous stunts, and anything else that'll get them some sense of gratification and ease their boredom with this dying world for just a bit longer. As long as it doesn't truly harm the One Person who is actually precious to them, that being their sister. As long as she's fine, almost anything goes. And once she's gone, Morgan's gone. Also, Morgan won't admit this because they love to preach their own independence to Hell and back, but... They want to be loved. They want affection. They're lonely and they'll be swindled into a mutually toxic relationship under just the right circumstances. I WONDER WHO COULD PULL THAT OFF??????

Sense of Justice: Morgan has it! Despite all their actions, they do have a moral compass. They will ALWAYS stand against bigotry and help the oppressed, because they KNOW what it's like. EMPATHY!!!!!!!!!!!!!! They're not a villain, they're just a really shitty hero. However, this means that they're very particular with Who they spend their justice on. They already know who Not to waste their time with: if you're rich, affiliated heavily with Saradomin, or just a plain asshole, then it doesn't matter HOW much you need a brave adventurer to come save you, you better pay up in cold hard cash. Otherwise, they're not gonna bother. Sorry!

How does Morgan behave around...

Masculine Presenting people: MOST do not earn Morgan's respect. SOME earn their fear by being taller and more imposing, and because Society or whatever. ALL are objects to be flirted with, relentlessly. Morgan sees male presenting individuals as an easy way to get money and pleasure, sometimes both at once. If a character is masculine, Morgan will typically be snarky, bratty, flirty—it depends on who it is. Example: The moment they saw Nabanik at the Dig Site for the first time and found out he's got a 'Dr.' title, they thought, "Ooooh, so he HAS to have money to have gotten through college! This should be fun..." And immediately they tried to seduce him into being another one of their sugar daddies. They were INCREDIBLY flustered to find out he was actually Azzanadra... Flustered for a few days, at least. Now that they've gotten to know him better, they try to sneak in some casual flirting here and there. The half hearted attempts mostly go over Azzy's head, luckily for Morgan, because if he Knew... He'd be Disappointed, to say the least. Anyway, does that sum it up? (Author's note: I do not condone this behavior, Morgan is just a little freak, I promise.)

Feminine Presenting people: Morgan is relentlessly attracted to most people who present in this way. They even tried to hold hands with Ariane during Rune Mysteries, but chickened out once she noticed. They're very shy around beautiful and powerful women, and almost SCARILY polite, uncharacteristically so. They kinda feel unworthy? Because they feel like they can never be that pretty. (Author's note: YES YOU CAN YOU SIMP) But overall, they feel a bit Safer in the company of feminine individuals, because, again, Society. (Author's note #2: I am projecting a bit here from my experiences living with mild androphobia aka: fear of men. I hope this doesn't offend anyone! I don't want to come off as sexist, writing these traits into characters just helps me work through them. If there's any problems or you think I oughta word this better, just let me know!)

Anyone in between those worlds: You Are Now Morgan's Friend. You Do Not Get A Say In The Matter. gender nonconforming folks gotta stick together!

Loved Ones: If Morgan cares about you, even a bit, their impulsiveness and deep need for affection will COMMAND them to protect you with their Goddamn life, even if you might not actually be deserving of it (cough SLISKE cough) because they've got some poor judgment sometimes, when it comes to the company they keep. At least one thing is a constant, however...

Lois (Their Sister): Morgan loves their sister. So Much. Let's talk about her for a second; she's about 21 months younger than Morgan (So two years and a month younger) and she was born Deaf. This does not make her helpless, but this is a medieval fantasy setting, do you really think they're gonna accommodate for disabilities that much? As a result, she's always been looked after, even coddled by her parents, and sometimes Morgan during moments of their own self doubt, but she's quite 'vocal' (despite being nonspeaking) about her distaste towards being treated this way.

She wasn't forced to run away from home with Morgan, she willingly went with them. That might partially be because their parents wanted to try invasive cures for her "debilitating condition" rather than just learn some Goddamn sign language, but other than that, she could have stayed happily with them, as they were never as abusive towards her as they were towards Morgan. But she went with Morgan, because their happiness mattered. Now she is rather self-sufficient, even finding herself a betrothed in Miscellania (We'll get to that later) and she has no problem communicating when people actually put in the effort to learn How to talk to her! It really is that easy! Basically, Morgan is an entirely different person around their sister. Reliable, nurturing, kind, gentle. Honest for once in their goddamn life. They'll Kill Anyone Who Hurts Her.

Enemies: Die. No second thoughts or second chances. Just die.

Dragons: Morgan's favorite creature. The Dragonkin are actually underwhelming in comparison, oddly enough. The less humanoid the better. Morgan wants to Be One.

Relationships

These are a work in progress, and may be added to/amended as I continue playing through the game with Morgan. Bear with me in regards to inaccuracies!

Romantic

Sliske: Morgan and Sliske are scarily similar, except Morgan has SOME morals and Sliske doesn't. Of course they're gonna fuck around. And that's what it starts as, really? Just friends with benefits. A mutual means to end their boredom and stave off their depression. Morgan isn't the one who accidentally catches feelings first, that shit catches up to them later, but let's not get into that!

Their arrangement starts sometime prior to FOTG, haven't figured out exactly when, but it definitely peaks after that quest, Morgan sees an opportunity to swoop in and take advantage of some rare vulnerability from Sliske. They even dye their hair aquamarine for him!!! They're ALMOST lovers until Kindred Spirits, where everything goes to shit.

Their relationship could also be hostile just based on Sliske's sheer need to Possess Every Aspect Of Morgan, and Morgan's strict desire NOT to be owned coming into conflict with that. They were doomed from the start, not to mention Sliske is well aware of their weak spots. If he fucks with just One Person, that being Lois, it's all over, he's dead to them... So y'all know him well enough to put two and two together.

Sliske is the most interesting person Morgan has ever met, and the feeling is sort of mutual. They're both perfect and horrid for each other.

Azzanadra: Opposites. Morgan is an absolute wreck, and Azzanadra appears to almost always have Everything about him put together, all tied up in a neat little bow, looking, acting, and sounding presentable at all times. Of course Morgan is gonna fall for that. HE was the REAL Desert Treasure, after all.

They start off with a teensy growing crush on him, but it suddenly peaks sometime after Endgame, a bit before his betrayal and subsequent ascension. Not only is Morgan super into the new Godly Aura he commands, but suddenly, something very Sliscean within them begins to rear its ugly, yet familiar head. Something that makes them feel like they've known Azzanadra for A Lot longer than they actually have. With this strange realization suddenly possessing them (no, literally) what used to be a tiny crush turns into Intense Need and Infatuation at the WORST TIME. LITERALLY DURING THE APOCALYPSE. THIS IS NOT THE TIME TO FUCK, LET ALONE FUCK A Z Z A N A D R A OF ALL PEOPLE!!!!!!!!!!

Mahjarrat in general: If you're a rock person Morgan wants a piece of you. Unless you're Lucien, fuck you Lucien.

Dragons: H-How'd this get here? Let's move on!

Ozan: Morgan and Ozan would make an unironically fantastic couple, or at least friends with benefits. They both joke around and play off of eachother fantastically, plus Ozan is HOT and does Parkour and lives in a desert. Morgan LOVES deserts and parkour and hot guys!

Ariane: Small teensy tiny crush. Mostly just Respect and awe of how cool and pretty she is.

Evil Dave: Morgan is responsible for finally ridding Evil Dave of his Evil Virginity, probably. I mean, it had to happen eventually! He was all for it, mind you, but he DID cry the whole time. (I'm mostly putting this in here as a joke for now, let's see if I like it enough to leave it in HAHAHAAAA)

Raptor: Morgan is so upset that he never takes off his Goddamn armor. SOMEONE CALL ARBY'S CUZ THEY WANT THE M E A T S.

Moia: she's hot but way out of morgan's league, plus she can be very scary. Given her abusive past, morgan is smart enough to realize she is Not girlfriend material, and thats ok! She just needs to recover from all that shit, somehow.

Friendly

Zanik: BEST GIRL BEST FRIEND!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!! Morgan GENUINELY gets really invested with the cave goblins and wants to aid them in any way they can. Zanik and Morgan make a GREAT team, just beating up bigots together, it's fantastic. After the events of The

Chosen Commander, Morgan and Zanik travel together for a bit, with the goal of dismantling HAM sects. They part ways in Kandarín after dismantling what's left of Sigmund's group there

Moia: I kinda wanna write Moia into Morgan's story earlier than she's actually introduced in canon, like maybe Morgan is fucking around in Daemoneheim for Mahjarrat answers and comes across her. They sympathize with her Abusive Parent situation and kinda get on friendly terms? This is increased when the 6th age rolls around shortly after, and Morgan vouches for the Zamorakian cause during the battle of Lumbridge. We all know everything kinda goes to shit during extinction, but for awhile these two are on decent terms.

Royalty of Miscellania: Remember when I mentioned Lois finding a betrothed on Miscellania? Well basically, after Morgan becomes a Fremennik (Not because they were invested in the culture or anything, literally they did it just to prove that they Could. Welcome to the salty spittoon how tough are ya, that kinda thing.) and they're tasked with the whole Miscellania thing, they're intimidated and put off by the IDEA of marriage, even if it's just political. The last person who should be managing a NATION is MORGAN, they can't even manage themselves! At any rate, they brought their sister along with them for the trip, and lucky for them, she and Brand fell in love. Probably because Brand, while charming, is too much of an earsore for most people to be able to look past his pitiful qualities and see the good in him. Thankfully, Lois can't hear a damn thing, so none of that matters! They genuinely fall for each other, and she marries into the royal family in Morgan's stead, saving them the trouble of having to be in any sort of authority position. As a result, the royalty of Miscellania are officially Morgan's in-laws, and they get along quite nicely with them. In turn, Miscellania takes fantastic care of Lois as their new Princess.

Kharshai: Tangentially related to the above, Morgan is on good terms with the friendlier, fluffier of the Mahjarrat. They put aside their unconditional lust for his entire species to actually respect him as a person. He also gets along pretty well with Lois, which is a fantastic bonus for Morgan.

Wahisietel: He's smart and reliable, which are rare qualities in Gielinor apparently (let alone among Mahjarrat) and visiting him is an excuse for Morgan to go to the desert. Pretty cool!

Relomia: She's cool (: in my canon I've decided she used to be Morgan's family maid when they were way too young to remember her, then she got lost in the shadow realm. She's the reason Sliske is able to find them, since he couldn't find anyone born with their name.

Neutral

Sir Owen: They find him tolerable, for being a white knight. They would usually find him attractive, but the heavy faith in Saradomin kinda gets in the way.

Most Royalty (Excluding Miscellania): If Morgan's getting paid or laid, they'll do the work for the big guys. They don't approve of the lifestyle of the rich and famous when there's people starving in the streets, but it's a whole lot of effort to try and anarchy their way through that

system and dismantle it from the inside. Most kingdoms will shoot themselves in the foot somewhere along the line anyway, Morgan doesn't have to do anything except Wait.

Devotees towards any faith (Excluding Saradominism): Morgan doesn't care. Just don't worship the blue guy.

Dislike

Their Parents: They weren't the WORST parents, but they were just unattentive enough that Morgan doesn't really have any fond memories towards them. They never saw any good potential in Morgan, and they doted on their sister Lois but only with the hope of being able to 'fix' her deafness. That's... not exactly the best impression.

Devotees towards Saradomin: Boring.

H.A.M: Morgan hates bigots.

GODS

Morgan's relationship with Gods is really weird, so let's unpack them one by one!

Saradomin: Morgan blames him for how their parents treated them growing up, because they used his beliefs to justify poor parenting skills. When he arrived on Gielinor after the edicts were abolished Morgan immediately cussed him out, the only thing restraining them from fully going mental on his blue ass was the fact that 1) it had already been a long day, they were very tired and 2) they were in shock by the fact that Gods were even real! They kinda thought they were allegory, but they just witnessed one die? And now the Popular Kid is back in town? So Morgan let him slide, but they truly don't wanna interact with his crusty ass for any reason. At least, that's how it is for a majority of the 6th age, but as they mature and grow as the world guardian, they do warm up to him. They're not about to let him rule the world but like, they're able to be in the same room as him and not claw their own eyes out.

Zamorak: He's always been a Fantasy Date for Morgan, he's on their Fuck list, which is sort of like a Bucket list, but for people you wanna fuck? I'm not funny, sorry. Morgan's allegiance to Zamorak is only skin deep, however. It's almost entirely aesthetic, and Morgan just clings to the Punk Rock Anti Establishment Anarchism that his beliefs imply. Morgan's always vibed with chaos in general, but actually meeting Zam is... Underwhelming. He's like Diet Cola Saradomin to them, just more disorganized. They're still really attracted to him, however, it's something they'll never really be able to shake.

Bandos: Morgan thinks that they could have done Bandos' ideology better. Just tune back the oppression. They kinda do have it in them to be a bit Bandosian, but what keeps them from it is knowing how much shit he gave the cave goblins, let alone Anyone who opposed him. Good riddance is an understatement for how they felt when he died.

Armadyll: Hasn't wronged Morgan. They like that he stands for Actual Justice, not just what HIS idea of Justice is. Morgan is all about helping the oppressed. Still, they aren't entirely swayed by his ideals yet, if only because they think they're just that— idealistic. It's hard to achieve Justice and Peace without a riot, ykno?

Zaros: The enigmatic nature of Zaros allures Morgan to no end, out of all the Gods, he's actually the closest Morgan gets to aligning with one of them. Call it simpleminded, and despite the part of Morgan that wants to be Free of Godly Authority, deep in their gut they just feel like he.. Knows something. And whatever it is, they want it on Their side.

Seren: Here's what Morgan thinks of her: y'know when there's a group of people being oppressed, and they actually fight back for once? But then there's someone on the 'neutral' side who's all like "Hey, no, don't do that! You'll make your cause look worse! We need to handle this with Love and Tolerance (:" and they MEAN well, but like... They're delusional. That's how Morgan views Seren. Dangerously pacifistic, and delusional. The lengths she will go to in order to maintain 'peace' does more harm than good, and Morgan simply can't stand it. It's like telling someone who's Literally On Fire to just Stay Calm, like, hello?

A neutral vote is a vote for the oppressor. Morgan just wishes she would realize that. Not to mention they're well aware of how her 'well meaning' actions have actually fucked over so many races, unintentional or no, she's almost as unforgivable as Saradomin in Morgan's book.

Guthix: Morgan has never really held any attachment to Guthix, he's just been... A constant. A silent presence always sleeping beneath the land. Sure, he gave them powers, and Morgan is thankful he chose THEM, because what other mortal is so willing to throw themselves into danger, over and over again? They may not be a hero, they may not actually Care much about the world, but they think he was smart to choose someone who already wanted to die, to take up the burden of World Guardian. But that being said, Morgan has only ever felt... Nothing about him. And that's how he wanted it, anyway, so there's no problem there. Right?

Ichthlarin: Good Dog. Friend.

Marimbo: Hedonistic Enabler. Friend.

Brassica: cabbage

DIFFERENCES IN MORGAN'S STORY VS CANON!!!!!!

Like other RS players, i like to twist canon to fit Morgan's narrative better. It's honestly like i view the plot of the game as a Basis for what i should write, as if im writing a tv show Inspired by it? So heres the differences in Morgan's story vs canon that matter the Most:

Sliske Fragment/Light and Shadow voice: in canon, this is apparently just the manifestation of the world guardian powers, and has nothing to do with sliske, ESPECIALLY nothing to do with

the fact that he stabbed us with the staff of armadyl at the end of endgame? In morgan's narrative im just... gonna ignore that. Its definitely sliske's essence possessing morgan. Think Ava's Demon, how wrathia shares a soul with ava, and is able to influence her actions and speak thru her, its very similar to that! And if Avas Demon doesnt ring any bells for u (highly recommend reading tho) then think about Eda the Owl Lady from the Owl House, and her curse. Sliske is basically a Curse. Altho, he was only able to do it to morgan Because of their WG powers and their very powerful soul. If morgan was just an ordinary person, he would have nothing to cling to, which is why the prospect of losing their WG powers after Twilight of the Gods is.. worrisome.

OVERALL at the end of the day, its just a fragment of him, his core personality is there, but the memories and feelings are a bit fuzzy. Its strong enough to drive morgan to crush on azzanadra, tho

Relomia: i said it above, ive decided relomia was morgan's maid during their childhood. It kinda lines up, theyre from ardougne, and relomia was a maid in ardougne at an unspecified point in the past, before she ended up in the shadow realm somehow. Im gonna put her as being much older than morgan in this case, to the point that morgan doesnt really remember her, so when they meet her again as sliske's emissary, they dont have any Lightbulb moment.

The main reason I'm giving her this connection to morgan is because of this: morgan's name is NOT their birth name. But it is the name that the asylum patient says to sliske, all those years ago, the name that sets him on a wild goose chase to find the world guardian and find out why theyre so important. Because morgan is a name they chose for themselves later in life, sliske wouldnt be able to track them from their birth, because 'morgan snow alexander' wouldnt exist. Therefore, relomia is the key to leading sliske right to them. Maybe after she gets out of the shadow realm, she might reminisce on her past and wonder, 'huh, what are those kids i used to serve all those years ago up to?' and she would find morgan, find out their name, and sliske would be like, "What Did You Just Say." its basically pure coincidence, because sliske and morgan r soulmates and were meant to find eachother HAHAAHAHA

I'm thinking for this to work, relomia would have to have been saved from the shadow realm when morgan is just starting their adventure, so when theyre 16. Idk, ill just roll with it.

Moia: said this above, but i think morgan and moia should meet and establish a friendship earlier than the Battle of Lumbridge. I think they could have good chemistry!
