Method

Method should contain: (1) research design and approach used, (2) population and sample (research subject/respondents), (3) instrument and data collection technique, and (4) Data analysis techniques used.

Result and Discussion

The title should correspond to the subject matter or description of the research question. This section contains the research findings and discussion related to the first research question. In the research findings section, present the obtained results first without including the author's personal interpretations or a literature review. The discussion section explains the research findings in relation to the research questions, interprets the findings, and compares or relates the findings to the referenced theories.
