Directions from Penn Hills: Take Beulah Road/Brown Avenue into Turtle Creek. At the Tri-Boro Expressway intersection, stay straight onto Shaw Avenue. At the stop sign, turn left onto Penn Avenue and then immediately turn right into the parking lot at 413 Penn Avenue.

Directions from Pittsburgh: Take 376 East (Parkway East) to the Churchill exit (79B). Turn left onto Beulah Road/Brown Avenue. Take that road into Turtle Creek. At the Tri-Boro Expressway intersection, stay straight onto Shaw Avenue. At the stop sign, turn left onto Penn Avenue and then immediately turn right into the parking lot at 413 Penn Avenue.

Directions from Braddock: Take Braddock Avenue out of Braddock. It will turn into the Tri-Boro Expressway. Once in Turtle Creek, by the Keystone Commons, stay straight to stay on Braddock Avenue (instead of staying on the Tri-Boro Expressway). Follow Braddock Avenue until it turns

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into Penn Avenue by the Human Services Center. Directly after the bend in the road, turn right into the parking lot at 413 Penn Avenue.

From North Versailles/McKeesport: Take the McKeesport/East Pittsburgh Boulevard to the Tri-Boro Expressway. Turn right onto the Tri-Boro. Once in Turtle Creek, by the Keystone Commons, stay straight to stay on Braddock Avenue (instead of staying on the Tri-Boro Expressway). Follow Braddock Avenue until it turns into Penn Avenue by the Human Services Center. Directly after the bend in the road, turn right into the parking lot at 413 Penn Avenue.

Important Information about your organization (mission, other work that you do, etc.):

The Human Services Center Mon Valley improves the quality of life for children, adults, and families in the Mon Valley area. All volunteers will receive an orientation to HSCMV, the work we do, and how to make referrals for other resources and programs available at our site.

CORE PROGRAMS

- **Emerging Leaders Program (ELP)**, a workforce and college readiness program for 155 low-income high school seniors (in five school districts — East Allegheny, McKeesport Area, Penn Hills, West Mifflin Area, and Woodland Hills).
- **Youth Learning In a Fun Environment After-School Program (Youth LIFE)** serves 80 youth in grades first through fifth daily with a comprehensive after-school program.
- **Kids Outgoing, Outdoing, and Learning Summer Program (KOOL)** serves 80 youth in first through fifth grade, seven hours a day, five days per week for seven weeks.
- **Supports for Success** provides intensive case management for at least 24 adults annually working toward self-sufficiency through an employment or training goal.
- The **Mon Valley Providers Council** serves as a formal network for information and resource exchange among 70+ dues paying human service providers in the Mon Valley.
- **Community Outreach Services** are the dozens of additional services that come to HSCMV to provide supplemental services in addition to the HSCMV's tenant agencies. This includes the HSCMV's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program, which helps over 700 low-income households annually get their taxes prepared for free, receiving nearly \$900,000 in returns last year. Additionally, HSCMV conducts financial literacy seminars assisting over 400 people annually. HSCMV also supports a food pantry for the 150+ lowest income families in the region.
