
## Top-It

**Materials:** A set of number cards with four cards each of the numbers 0-10, a penny (optional)



2 + 5 = 7

Number of Players: 2 or 3

## **Directions:**

- 1. Shuffle the cards and place the deck number-side down on the playing surface.
- 2. Each player turns over two cards and creates an addition number sentence.
- 3. The player with the greatest sum wins the round and takes all the cards.
- 4. In the case of a tie, each player turns over two more cards and determines their sum. The player with the greatest sum then takes all the cards from both plays.
- 5. Play ends when not enough cards are left for each player to have another turn.
- 6. The player with the most cards wins.

Digit Top-It: Each player turns over one card at a time and the player with the bigger number wins that round.

Addition with 3 Cards: Use the same rules as for addition top-it but use 3 cards for each turn.

**Subtraction:** Use the same rules as for addition top-it but subtract the smaller digit from the larger digit. Decide before beginning if the larger or smaller difference will win for each round.

Multiplication Top-It: Players turn over two cards and multiply the digits to find the product. The player with the greater product wins the round. When ready for a challenge, play with 3 cards and compute the product for the three numbers.
