Abstract

Abstract is a short summary of your article, giving readers an overview of its main points and covering all the contents of the article. Abstract should be typed using font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt, spacing 1.0, the spacing before and after the paragraph is 0 cm, and justify aligned. Abstract contains the title, author(s)'s name, background, objectives, methods, results, and conclusions. The abstract is written as one paragraph, with subsections in bold and a colon before the next word. Abstract typed in proper English with maximum 250 words and does not contain citations and references. The first sentence of the paragraph is not be indented.

Keywords: *Keywords can be single words or compound words consisting of 3 – 5 words, font size 10 pt, typed below the abstract, typed in italic, and justify aligned.*

Instruction

Before you begin, make sure to read the instructions and guidelines in the template. Then, **delete this instruction and the explanations in each sub-section.**

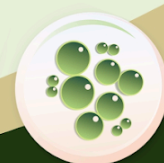
1. General Terms

Use a 2-column format from the introduction sections until the bibliography sections (except the abstract) on A4 paper, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt, sentence case (only the first letter of the first word of a sentence is

capitalized), justify aligned, spacing 1.0, the spacing before and after the paragraph is 0 cm. Please follow the writing format and instructions in the template and guideline. Any changes of the writing format may effect the scoring of the manuscript.

2. Tables and Images

The maximum number of tables, graphics, and images is 5. If the tables/graphics/images have two columns in size, the column (the part of the paragraph where the



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tables/images are placed) can be changed to single column.

Each table, graphic and image is numbered according to Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3, and so on).

The title of the table is placed above the table, meanwhile the title of the image or graphic is placed below the image or graphic, typed in font Times New Roman, font size 10 pt, with capital letters at the beginning of each word in the title, not in bold, and centered of the table, graphic, or image.

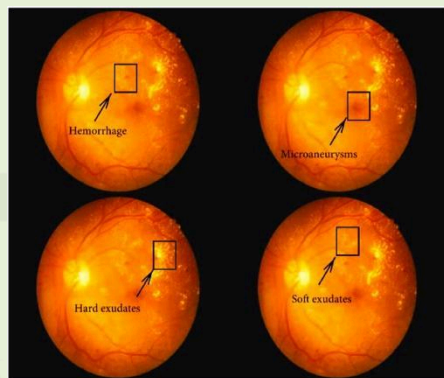


Image 2. Different Lesions Linked to DR ^[2]

3. Abbreviations and Acronyms

Abbreviations and acronyms are explained when abbreviations and acronyms are mentioned for the first time in the manuscript (except the abstract). Abbreviations and acronyms mentioned in the abstract should be re-explained if they are used in the body of the manuscript.

4. Finalization

The manuscript is 5 – 10 pages, does not include bibliography and attachment sections. Please follow the instruction, guideline, writing format, and the template. Save the manuscript in **.pdf** format.

INTRODUCTION (the section title is left-aligned, all caps, bold, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt)

The introduction should be an essay that includes background, any related research already published (if applicable), the new ideas being proposed, and the objectives of the research or writing.^[1] Typed in proper English, and use italic for foreign words.^[2]

METHOD (the section title is left-aligned, all caps, bold, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt)

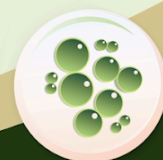
The methods section explains how the author gathered the data and information for the literature review. It should cover the types of sources, search strategies, and keywords used.^[3]

RESULT AND DISCUSSION (the section title is left-aligned, all caps, bold, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt)

The discussion section analyzes issues using data, information, and literature to come up with alternative solutions or creative ideas.^[4] It can include tables, graphics, and images to support the ideas. Any abbreviations in these elements should be explained in the footnotes.

CONCLUSION (the section title is left-aligned, all caps, bold, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt)

The conclusion answers the research questions and fulfils the specific



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objectives. It should be written as an essay without numerical data from the study. The conclusion has maximum three paragraphs, summarizing the main findings, limitations, and potential future research.

RECOMMENDATION (the section title is left-aligned, all caps, bold, font Times New Roman, font size 12 pt)

The recommendations offer suggestions for actions that should be taken by one or more groups based on the conclusions. These suggestions should be written as an essay.

The references are typed in Vancouver style, numbering in order of appearance, not alphabetically.
