

Nicole Tang, Grade 8








Sunset view on top of Rockefeller Center in New York City.








The photo is a picture from my trip to Tahoe in California. It is meaningful to me because I used to live in California. I hope that people will see California's beauty when they look at the photo.






This photo is a picture of a child chasing the birds on the beach. This picture is meaningful to me because this was on one of my favorite vacations and this vacation was spent with my family.


I took this picture when I was visiting Turkey in August. This is The Tomb of Amynthas located on a cliff overlooking the town of Fethiye (ancient Telmessos).




This is a picture of Lake Massapoag which is one of my favorite places in Sharon. This picture shows the reflection of the fall leaves changing color on the trees.




This was in Perth, Australia. It was my first ever time to see a red sun, and I don't know how it happened, but I do know that I would love to see one again!!!








This photo was taken in the Netherlands, during summer break. I was on a small walk with my family in the town that we were staying in.


This is a photo of a part of Nantucket. I took the picture on a boat. This photo is meaningful to me because I took it when on a family vacation which was a very special memory.






This is a drone photo including the Sharon landscape and the new Sharon high school. This is meaningful to me and others because that is where we will eventually go to school.



Winner - Third Place - Hanson Cheung - Grade 8






This is a photo that was taken at Horseshoe Bend. Its beauty has been standing in Page, Arizona for millions of years for people and for wildlife.
