Since BH Houston there's a few changes I wanted to make to how I play

Picking the best hero for me: (**A+**) I think I did that well, Oscilio is so fun and interesting in so many aspects that I'm happy to put in the hours and learn the ins and outs of other options **Exploring more angles and testing stuff I otherwise would not: (A)** I think I tested many different side board options and even made some main deck tweaks to test the different ways I can play matchups, I think I succeeded however I could still do more

Figure out what is actually core to the deck to make testing other things easier: (A+) I definitely figured out my Oscilio core really well! Helped a lot when testing how to tackle different matchups and sideboard

Keep an open mind about lines that may be unintuitive: (B) I did well in this basically all the way until I tunnel visioned on that comet storm Imao.

Use resources available to me to reach out to test new matchups or learn new things: (C) Talking to Bear, Yuuto and the others definitely helped but I did not reach out to test matchups nearly as much as I should. I'm not sure any losses I had were affected by lack of testing outside of the Ira matchup, which seemed rough to begin with.

Changing mindset: I will very often leave the venue after a rough performance and be really in the dumps but as I was sitting on the edge at 3-2 I was ready to lose and still feel good. I tested the hero well, I played to the best of my ability, and had fun with a hero I loved. Even if I didn't reach the goal destination, I enjoyed the journey. I set out to do my best, and still accomplished something.
