- Ensure that Community Team efforts are aligned with the larger Black in Gaming Non-Profit Organization
- Ensure that the behavior of online members follows Black in Gaming's code of conduct
- Maintain relationships and alignment with other parts of Black in Gaming Org
- Producer Mindset Ability to organize meetings, understanding of tasks across different teams
- Help manage team budget with other organizers
- Proficiency with Discord from a moderator or server owner perspective. Ex. creating channels, roles, server setting modification, using bots, etc.
