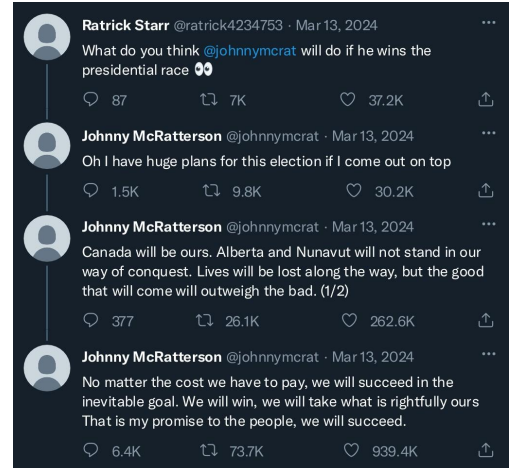


Canadian Rat Presidential Race Heats Up
