



Wasilla Youth Soccer Association Valley Revolution Mandatory Reporting Policy

Purpose:

To ensure the safety, protection, and well-being of all players, staff, and volunteers by establishing clear requirements for reporting suspected abuse, neglect, misconduct, or safety concerns.

- **Mandated Reporters:**

All coaches, staff, volunteers, and representatives of WYSA are mandated reporters who are legally required to report any suspected abuse, neglect, harassment, or misconduct involving minors or other vulnerable individuals associated with WYSA.

- **Scope of Reporting:**

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Physical, emotional, or sexual abuse
- Neglect or endangerment
- Harassment or discrimination
- Safety violations or concerns

- **Reporting Procedures:**

- Incidents should be reported immediately to the designated personnel, the Executive Director.
- If the situation involves the designated personnel (ED), report directly to local child protective services, law enforcement, or appropriate authorities as required by law.
- All reports must be documented accurately and kept confidential to the extent possible, consistent with legal and safety obligations.

- **Protection of Reporters:**

WYSA prohibits retaliation against anyone who reports concerns in good faith. All reports will be taken seriously and handled with appropriate confidentiality.

*WYSA complies with all state and local laws regarding mandatory reporting of child abuse and neglect.
