Positive Behavior Incentives & Rewards

Each day, our students have the opportunity to earn positive behavior points/tickets for demonstrating the <u>RAVENS Core Beliefs</u> in their classes, the hallway, cafeteria, etc. In addition to our RAVENS core beliefs, students participated in creating their grade level Social Contracts in which they came to consensus on how they wanted to be treated by each other, how they wanted to be treated by their teacher, how their teacher wanted to be treated by them, and how they could resolve conflict in an appropriate way. This year, we will have Fun Friday every 2-3 weeks in which students can cash in points/tickets to participate in fun activities during AIR Time. In order to participate, students cannot have any missing work (outside of an excused absence) and cannot have been assigned ISS or OSS during the previous 3 weeks. Students have been earning LOTS of points in their classes and are excited to cash them in for our fun activities!

Technology Use Agreement Forms

All students should have received a paper copy of the JCPS Technology Use Agreement Form in Homeroom the first week of school. These forms MUST be signed and returned in order for students to have access to their Chromebook during the school day. Students will be issued a Chromebook to use during the school day only. No Chromebooks can be taken home and must be charged in the classroom ChromeCart each night.

23-24 Academic Accomplishments

During the 2023-2024 school year, RMS EOG proficiency data increased by 5% from 52.2% to 57.2%, one of only eight schools in JCPS to improve by at least 5% on EOG composite. We had the second highest EL progress of all JCPS schools, as well as the 2nd highest Reading EOG scores out of all traditional middle schools. All tested subjects improved proficiency from the previous year, some as much as 13.9%! Additionally, discipline was reduced by over 30% from the previous year. Overall, we increased our final School Performance Grade (SPG) by 7 points, moving from a 51/D to 58/C and are officially out of low performing status!!

We have set our School Improvement Goals for this year to increase by at least another 5% in EOG proficiency and are pleased that we are currently FULLY STAFFED in all core content areas! We also have goals to improve the proficiency of our Students with Disabilities subgroup and increase student daily attendance to at least 93%. Our teachers and students will be setting their own individual and class goals throughout the year for proficiency and growth, which will be tracked using the MAP and MVP benchmark assessments.

We are so excited to see how well our students perform this year as we continue to work towards regaining a status of a B school performance grade! We are thankful for the support of our parents and community as we continue to make improvements with both academics and school culture!

RMS Carpool

Carpool drops off and picks up in the front of the school, entering off Athletic Club Blvd. Please follow the direction of the staff directing carpool and bring patience this week. It will be slower this week but by the end of the week, things will be running smoothly and we will get you and your child through the line quickly.



Remember that you cannot enter the carpool lane before 7:00 am in the morning or 2:55 pm in the afternoon. Until then, carpool drivers must wait on the side of Athletic Club Blvd at the end of the school.
