2. Referendum Update (CAA)
 - a. Collective frustration to the MIT administration (for not listening to the undergrads), fear of facing consequences from administration
 - b. Urgency of addressing the connections to Israel – situations in Gaza
 - c. UA role to speak and represent the student voices
 - i. **Ask that UA P and VP use speaking privileges to speak at Faculty Meeting on April 17th, 2024**
 - ii. **Accept and vote on an ad-hoc committee to interpret and implement Referendum 2**
 - d. Q: What would the ad-hoc committee do?

A: Understanding that after voting on referendum in support, this is the stance that the UA will take, ad-hoc committee will work on communicating demands of Referendum 2 to administration

Q: What is the work?

A: Work with admin or work to convince admin? UA should have more power than the average undergraduate, use that power to push the demands more strongly on administration

Not a standing committee and hopefully provide an opportunity to be able to advocate but allow the UA leaders to work on the projects they will have to continue to work on.
