## Disney Trip 2025 FAQ

#### Is this the final itinerary?

No, this is our working document. This gives a rough idea of travel dates and potential dates/times in parks. A final itinerary will be shared as we get closer to our travel date.

#### What are the performances?

We will be performing in one of the Magic Kingdom parades...right down Main Street USA! Students will also participate in the You're Instrumental Workshop where they will go into the Disney recording studios as professional musicians! A Disney clinician will share what it's like to record soundtracks for the various Disney platforms! We will leave that workshop with our students performing the soundtrack to a Disney Movie!

#### What is not included in the trip price?

Travel insurance, select meals, spending money, souvenirs

#### Is this the final cost?

As with any travel these days there is the possibility of additional costs. We are traveling with a new company this year and used them for the Fall New York trip. They were fantastic and very transparent with all our communications and concerns. I do not anticipate any fluctuations in the cost of the trip.

#### What should I do about Trip Insurance?

Trip insurance is NOT added into the stated cost of the trip. This is an additional purchase you will make through the Bob Rogers Travel portal. While the Walled Lake Consolidated School district is no longer making travel insurance mandatory for every participant, please understand that the District retains the right to cancel the trip. I highly recommend that each participant purchase travel insurance.

#### How do I make payments?

## What kind of fundraising will be available?

#### How will my fundraising be applied to the trip?

All fundraising monies will be applied to the last payment of the trip.

## How can I be a Chaperone on this trip?

All parents who wish to be a chaperone must fill out the <u>Chaperone Interest Form</u>. We must travel with at least a 1 to 8 student to chaperone ratio. The number of chaperones will be dependent on the number of students who register for the trip and determined after the Deposit date. (May 24th, 2024)

#### What happens if my student breaks a rule?

If your student breaks the law or school rule they will be sent home at the expense of the parents. You will not remain on the trip if you are unable to follow the rules.

# Does my student (or as a chaperone) need to fly with the group (i.e. full package versus just land package)?

Yes, all participants must arrive and depart with the group. I will not be able to manage individual itineraries. We are not offering a land only package.

#### Can I extend my trip either before or after the scheduled trip dates?

No, we will not be able to accommodate this request.

#### Who can go on the trip?

At this point, this trip is only open to current members of the 2025 WLN Band Program and their parents. Should both parents attend as chaperones and there are siblings who are not in band who wish to attend, please reach out to Mrs. Hulliberger.

## Can you explain the type of duties a chaperone must do?

Chaperones are responsible for the wellbeing of their students. Highlights include: check ins, bed checks, bus ride check ins, emergency procedures, maintaining communication with their students and following all directions from Mrs. Hulliberger.

## If I chaperone do I have to follow the itinerary with the band?

Yes, there will not be any deviations from the schedule. You will be with us for the entirety of the trip in the capacity of chaperone.

#### Is my Deposit refundable?

No, we are booking airfare right away. Your deposit will not be refunded.
