Once you are selected you will hear that you have been unmuted: At this time, please state your first name, last name, and county you reside in for the record. In order to receive the full zoom experience, please make sure your Zoom application is up to date.

c. Public Comment by Email

You may also submit comments by email to sbc:wm@sanbenitocountyca.gov by 5:00 PM on the day prior to the IWM Local Task Force meeting. Regardless of whether the matter is on the agenda, every effort will be made to provide the IWM Local Task Force with your comments before the agenda item is heard.

Public Comment Guidelines

- The IWM Local Task Force welcomes your comments.
- Each individual speaker will be limited to a presentation total of three (3) minutes, or such other time as may be designated by the Chair.
- If there are more than ten (10) speakers on any given item, speakers will be given two (2) minutes to speak to be able to give everyone the opportunity to speak.
- Speakers are encouraged to keep your comments brief and to the point, and do not repeat prior testimony, so that as many people as possible can be heard. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Failure to Comply with the above guidelines:

- 1. The individual may be asked to leave the Board Chambers.
- 2. The Chair may call a recess of the IWM Local Task Force meeting.
- 3. If the recess does not result in the individual complying with the above requirements or leaving the meeting, the IWM Local Task Force may close the meeting to the public and resume the meeting at a later scheduled date.

Alternatively, the IWM Local Task Force may take other action as they deem necessary for the orderly conduct of the meeting.
