Executive Order 020: Task Force to Promote the Acceptance of the LGBTQ+ Community Around the World

May 17th, 2020

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, I, Gunnz011, do:

SECTION 1 POLICY

It shall be the policy of the executive branch of the United States government to promote the acceptance of the LGBTQ+ community around the world. Around the world members of the LGBTQ+ community are attacked, mistreated, and put down by some foreign governments. The United States of America is committed and has always been committed to ensuring that all people are treated equally across the world. The Department of State, led by the Secretary of State, shall take the lead on a task force to promote the acceptance of all members of the LGBTQ+ community around the world, to try and end the persecution and mistreatment of the community.

SECTION 2 Task Force

- 1) I hereby direct the Secretary of State to establish, and to appoint and designate an individual to chair, a Task Force to promote the acceptance of the LGBTQ+ community around the world. The Secretary of State shall also provide funding and administrative support to the task force.
- 2) The Secretary of State shall determine the overall characteristics of the Task Force, which will be composed of fifteen members designated and appointed by the Secretary of State.
- 3) The Task Force shall:
 - a) Identify which nations around the world allow legal discrimination against members of the LGBTQ+ community.

- b) Discuss ideas and information, amongst the members, to find solutions and strategies to promote the acceptance of the LGBTQ+ community in the designated nations that are found in section 2, 3(a).
 - c) Find ways to successfully promote the overall acceptance of the LGBTQ+ community in every nation across the world.
- 4) The Task Force shall meet as requested and required by the Secretary of State and shall only be dissolved once it has accomplished the goals as set forth in section 2(3), as determined by the Secretary of State.
- 5) The Task Force shall submit at least one report to the president within 6 months of the date of this order, and shall submit at least one report to the president per year every year that the Task Force is in existence after the first 6 month report.

SECTION 3 General Provisions

- a) This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- b) This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against the United States, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, employees, or agents, or any other person.
