

First Grade Behavior Feedback

Dear Parents,

The following are behavior expectations for all students in the first grade. Students are expected to exhibit these abilities with minimal guidance to receive a 2 on their report card, independently to receive a 3, and above grade level standards to receive a 4. When a student receives no written feedback on their calendar, it indicates that they are meeting the behavior expectation with minimal guidance.

As they develop leadership in these behaviors, students will receive stickers in their folders. Teachers will indicate in which areas students are showing leadership. If students need several reminders about an exhibiting a behavior expectation(s), teachers will note this on their calendar by noting what behavior occurred. The number of behavior related comments in a nine week period will determine the number students receive on their report cards, as listed in the table below:

Number of behavior related comments in a nine week period	Number student would receive on the report card
10+	1
6-9	2
3-5	3
0-2	4

It is our hope that we can “catch” them in leadership as we progress throughout this school year.
