Hugo Pierre Leclercq, better known as Madeon, is an electronic music artist hailing from the city of Nantes, France. Good Faith is his second studio album, recontextualising many of the themes and iconic symbols of the Adventure Era.

The Good Faith Era encompasses more than just an album; it encompasses joy, the search for joy, the loss of joy to darkness, and the battle to reclaim it. This is represented through the visual design, storytelling, and sound of the era. To those who are dedicated to understanding the Good Faith Era and its many mysteries, Hugo leaves cryptic messages, physical and digital puzzles, and more.

18th of July, 2020: <u>Another Instagram Livestream</u>. He plays a couple demos, says Good Faith Radio coming next week, and ways a Music Video is coming soon 20th of July, 2020: <u>Good Faith Radio 5 officially announced</u>

21st of July, 2020: Good Faith Radio 5 airs. Secret Message was a <u>photo with Base 64</u> that translated to "The Prince Will Lead To <u>Celine</u>" <u>Morse Code</u> translated to 12122017.

28th of July, 2020: madeon <u>teases</u> a music video of a then-unknown song

29th of July, 2020: <u>Miracle music video</u> premieres at 8am PST. <u>It is not related to the Good Faith canon</u>

5th of August, 2020: madeon <u>answers</u> 4 out of a total 11 questions asked by fans via Proximity

6th of August, 2020: madeon asks a "<u>Legitimate, non rethorical question</u>" about if he should release The Prince.

12122017

7th of August, 2020: madeon officially announced The Prince as a single, <u>releasing</u> on the 14th of August.

14th of August, 2020: The Prince releases. HD Bundle of The Prince releases in madeon.store. Has a maze in the spectrogram. <u>Official video releases</u>. Leads to the <u>twelvetwentyseventeen video</u>, 12122017 instagram, <u>Celine12122017</u>, <u>MRSL Twitter</u>, and "it's a rotating world" Instagram and website.

30th of March, 2022: The Adventure Deluxe Vinyl finally goes on sale. Together is included after Only Way Out as a bonus track

A Guide to the Good Faith Era

Introduction

This section of the document is dedicated to the many recurring entities, concepts, and phrases of the Good Faith Era - with a particular emphasis on the lore and ARG. It is ordered in such a way that the reader understands the context and importance of later entries. Information is repeated where relevant. The era has 3 distinct layers. The first one is based on the real life events that led to the Good Faith project. The third is the mythologized version of these real life events. The second, in-between layer is what is commonly referred to as the ARG Layer. It's where the fictional companies of the era reside, and they take their names and imagery from the mythology. Good Faith Live/Forever exists in and is created by this second layer but is about the third layer. The live show exists as a metaphor for the first layer.

- There may be different Architects divisions, Hugo mentions an "Architects Puzzle Team" in an email, which we are relatively sure included <u>Enigmida</u>.
- They have a website & three known logos.
- The purpose of thearchitects.fr is unknown.
- They were mentioned in the Pixel Empire Podcast episode.
- Their logos appear in Good Faith Live and DJ Set visuals numerous times.
- LA is the "Architects HQ" according to the vinyl and Japanese CD.
- Conduct "Special Presentations" in collaboration with Madeon.
- There is an "Architects Secret Club" that helped create the secret DJ Set at The Roxy & the one in Paris
- Mentioned in imperial in the Good Faith Live crew jacket.
- A reversed and mirrored primary logo is the solution of the <u>twelvetwentyseventeen instagram</u> puzzle.
- This reversed logo is seen on http://stcetihcraeht.fr in red.
- One of the <u>two alternative Architects</u> logos appears on the NFNM Remix and the beginning of <u>The Prince Visualiser</u> (notably more recent releases use this).
 - The same logo is mirrored as the logo for HWH.

Daedalus Production

- They have a website, which has thus far teased music.

- Madeon commissioned a <u>suede jacket</u> with their logo on the back, as seen on <u>Zine one & vinyl cover</u>. He also created a cheaper version of the jacket for sale on madeon.store.
- Their <u>logo</u> appeared on the front of the popup shop alongside the datamatrix code for goodfaith.world/secret.
- Additionally, Hugo has sold a shirt named 'Daedalus Band Tee' promoting Good Faith Live. It depicts an iconic frame from the Icarus live edit.
- May be in charge of the musical aspect of the era, with All My Friends are Asleep, and BF1.wav/BF2.wav being found on their site
- Logo appears on the album cover
- Shows up in the corner of <u>this Good Faith Live visual</u> alongside Mania, Forever, and The Same Sunrise

Dreamx3

- Responsible for the vast majority of visual design in the Good Faith Era.
- Are credited as 'Visual FX' in the All My Friends Music Video
- They have a website which hints at graphic design
- The Imperial on the website reads:

GRAPHIC DESIGN

DIGITAL RGB PROFILE ART PHYSICAL HOLO LAND ALT ART

- Dreamx3.com is understood to be the first available site from the Good Faith Era, it was meant to be found using clues from a PEP episode. We were unable to find it until long after its airing, however.
- NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH THE SINGLE, despite their clear relation to one another.

Imperial Studio

- On the back of the jacket Madeon wore on the first <u>billboard</u> & the old background on goodfaith.world [<u>close up photo from the Pop-up</u>]

- "Fictitious Company" within Good Faith.
- Logo is strongly associated with the song Mania.
- May be related to the runes.
- Appears on the Imperial Flag.
- The Imperials of Good Faith Live are related to this company in some capacity.
- Very little is known about their role outside of Good Faith Live.
- The company remains strangely absent from the ARG.
- Their logo appears on the ironing board DJ set thumbnails
- Logo titled the "Imperial Lion" and was conceived in early 2018, based on the Nemean Lion of Greek Mythology.

Happy Humans

- Exact status as a company is unclear.
- Meant to be a dangerous optimistic cult. In the same vein as the lyrics of Be Fine
- Initially appeared as concept art on the wall, and at the popup.
- Has two logos which have seen varied use, the <u>first logo</u> appears predominantly in DJ set visuals and concept art, <u>the second</u> appears during LYBxBeings' live edit.
- Has appeared with a navy blue and yellow colour scheme.
- Has appeared in DJ sets, starting in 2020 at <u>WWFest</u> and <u>OMFG NYE 2020</u>
- DJ Set visuals reference Be Fine. [1] [2]
- Heavily associated with LYB and BF

Eternal Eye

- May be a mythical entity within Good Faith lore, or may be a company.
- First seen in Good Faith Live visuals during the Shelter Encore.
- Has two known logos, the second also being HMJB's logo.
- "Eternal" may bear reference to Forever.

Media

"The Wall"

- A wall in Hugo's home that is covered with concept art from Good Faith
- Seen in the <u>VINYL HUNT</u> video, <u>Ironboard Sets</u>, and some instagram story posts []
- Parts of this wall were on display at the <u>LA Pop-up shop</u>, where it was called the Good Faith Documents.
 - Some photos: [] [2] [3] [4] [5] [6] [7] [8] [9] [10] [11] [12] [13] [14] [15] [16] [17] [18] [19] [20] [21] [22]

- Most <u>Instagram livestreams</u> use it as a backdrop.
- The concept art extends beyond the central, circular wall often shown, according to the <u>DJ Mag interview</u>.
 - This likely indicates that more art of upcoming/secret projects is on display around the house.
- Has been referred to as the "Good Faith Mural" and "Good Faith Documents" but is also unofficially called "The Wall".

Good Faith Radio

- Madeon's show on Apple's Beats 1 radio that happens seemingly at random.
- Usually advances the ARG in way of clues between songs.
 - A breakdown of the clues from each episode are available in the <u>ARG</u>
 <u>Chapters section</u>
- The current situation of the show is murky. There is a possibility that it may currently be on hiatus for an extended period of time.

Good Faith Live

- A live show that aims to provide a unique audiovisual experience to its viewers whilst retelling the story of Good Faith.
- The show's canon is separate to the canon of the Good Faith Era as a whole, but it still tells a similar story.
- Madeon's live show debuted at Lollapalooza 2019, its final showing was part of the EDC Mexico festival in late 2019.
- There are two variations of this show, a full length cut (shown over the American tour), and a shortened version shown as lollapalooza and Europe.
- Now replaced by Good Faith Forever.

- THIS SECTION IS A WORK IN PROGRESS AND INCOMPLETE

Good Faith Forever

- Also known as Good Faith Live V3 and V4 (with V4 yet to be played in 2022).
- It reworks to story aspects of Good Faith Live and introduces Madeon as a canon character.
- It is a topic of debate how its new story segments interact with those originally established in Good Faith Live. However, Hugo likes to think of the new additions as "DLC". The meaning of this is unclear.
- Originally planned to be called 'Good Faith Future'.

- THIS SECTION IS A WORK IN PROGRESS AND INCOMPLETE

An s Some LA Pop-up

- An exhibition at <u>Agency Coffee</u> in Los Angeles showcasing various Good Faith Era artwork and items.
- Was open on the 16th and 17th of November of 2019.
- Also showcased some <u>merch items</u>, some of which were exclusively sold there [1] [2] [3]
- Also contained various Good Faith exhibits like the Imperial Pendants [2] [3], the AMF vinyls, costumes from the live-action scenes from GFL [2] [3], the Architect Jeans [2] [3], Daedalus Jacket [2], the Imperial Coat [2] [3] [4], and parts of the Good Faith Documents [1] [2] [3] [4] [5] [6] [7] [8] [9] [10] [11] [12] [13] [14] [15] [16] [17] [18] [19] [20] [21] [22]
- Other photos from the shop [] [2] [3] [4] [5] [6] [7] [8] [9] [10] [11] [12] [13] [14]
- Madeon recorded his talking and Q&A bits for GFR 4 in the pop-up
- For closing, Madeon played a DJ Set to which both San Holo and Jaron showed up.

All My Friends Music Video

- The Daedalus Jacket, Good Faith pants, and the Imperial R Jacket all appear
- <u>Burnt Datamatrix</u> makes a brief appearance.
- Made in a week spontaneously.
- Visual FX credited to DreamX3 (actually made in collaboration with Glassface).
- Upside down imperial translates to "...tion.The fever" [Full Line]
 - "Out of the fever" is a lyric in AMF, but this sign does not match it.

Miracle Music Video

- Directed by Game of Thrones star Lena Headey.
- The lead roles were portrayed by renowned British actors Maisie Williams and James Nelson-Joyce.
- According to Hugo, he was approached by Headey while touring. Impressed by her vision for the song, he gave his blessing.
- Completely separate from the lore of Good Faith.

FOUR CITIES (Los Angeles, New York, Alesund, Nantes)

- Described by Madeon as the cities most vital to the making of Good Faith.
- First referenced in the All My Friends Vinyl Hunt.
- Mentioned in the vinyl and Japanese CD.
- A Circle with the FOUR CITIES' names is hidden in the source code of <u>https://thearchitects.fr</u>

- The idea for Good Faith stad during the end of the Adventure-era during a three day session in New York
- According to an interview, Hugo and the architects stayed in Alesund for a month and then went on a trip throughout the US until eventually moving to LA.
- The <u>www.itsarotating.world/12122017/</u> puzzle features locations within the FOUR CITIES.

Good Faith Vinyl

- Teased during the **Phoenix Instagram stream**.
- Gatefold, contains one 12" disc including all 10 songs from Good Faith. No bonus tracks.
- Inside, concept images are collaged over the two sides of the gatefold.
- Interior of the gatefold references many things from the ARG, notably Liquid Faith, FOUR CITIES, pages from zine one, the runes, and the billboards.
- The arrangement of images on the gatefold was relevant to the 12122017 ARG.
- Many of these images also appeared on the popup store wall.
- The Architects logo in Heavy With Hoping is rotated 180 degrees more than it is on the digital cover.
- The Borealis logo on the digital cover has periods between every letter. Which Hugo cited the periods as a kerning method, **Borealis is NOT an acronym**.
- Scan of the <u>runes</u> on the vinyl cover.

Good Faith Zine Issue 02

- Currently unreleased.
- Planned to commemorate Good Faith Forever.
- Focuses on the making of the live show.
- In 2020, Hugo stated that he was having trouble thinking of an item to bundle the zine with.
- Later it was stated that the zine would be something akin to an art book.
- Hugo is unsure whether to release zine 02 in multiple volumes, or all at once.

Runes/No Love

- Jumble of various scripts and characters bearing strong resemblance to several languages and unicode categories, including but not limited to:
 Ancient Latin, Arabic, Bengali, Cyrillic, Dingbats, Georgian, Imperial, Kannada, Mathematical Symbols, Norse, Runic, Tagbanwa, Vai, and Yi
- There are no apparent patterns to any arrangements in the runes.
- Appears in Good Faith Live's visuals, during Nirvana, in Zine 01, the Pop-up shop and the top right hand corner of the vinyl gatefold without the signature curve.

- A photo of Madeon writing the runes appears in the Mania page for Zine 01 and the <u>banner for the MRSL twitter.</u>
- The <u>No Love Square</u> is a DJ Set visual, and a small, cropped section of the runes [First seen at Second Sky].
- The only certainly deciphered words from the runes are 'Liquid Faith'.
- The meaning of the runes is unclear.
- Bears a striking resemblance to the album cover for <u>Joy Division Unknown</u> Pleasures

12122017

- The name of a secret EP made by Hugo 'out of anger' on the 12 of December, 2017 (it was actually recorded on the 6th of December, but Hugo revealed that he thought the 12th sounded better).
- Is meant to represent the darkness that recontextualized Good Faith: <u>"Good Faith is about the joy I've snatched from the hands of darkness. I thought this document [12122017] could be of interest to people who are really interested in understanding Good Faith".</u>
- Initially teased in Zine 01 via a barcode and additionally via goodfaith.world/SECRET.
- Has an <u>Instagram</u> account that was found during the ARG.
- BARCODE/Good Faith Radio 3
- Appeared in morse code of the secret message in GFR 5.
- Barcode from zine one appears as the tag of the 12122017 Shirt.

Enigmida

- Puzzle-making design studio based in San Francisco that have assisted in the creation of ARG chapters
- Have their own Instagram and Facebook.
- Assisted in the creation of the 12122017 ARG.
- Team of two.
- Evidently part of the Architects Puzzle Team.
- Keep an eye out for them over "the coming years", according to a sadly unarchived IG Live.

Greek Mythology References

- Hugo often recontextualizes Greek Mythos in his projects.
- Often, he uses characters, places, and connections between figures.
- This has been a recurring theme since the start of Imperial's use in his work.
- It began with the releases of Technicolor, Icarus, and The City.
- Imperial appeared on the disc sleeves for their respective limited vinyl releases: (update pictures)

- Technicolor: WE CAN GET IT BACK.
- Icarus: ICARUS/WE WILL TRY AGAIN.
- Parallels can be drawn between the building in Technicolor's cover art and the <u>Palace of Knossos</u>, or more fitting, <u>The Tower of the Winds</u>.
- This era vaguely retells the myth of Icarus and Daedalus.
- The Adventure Era also incorporates this story into its lore in both the Adventure music videos, and deluxe edition of the Adventure album.
- The Adventure music videos follow <u>Asteria</u> (possibly the <u>Titaness Asteria</u>), and <u>Icarus</u> as they attempt to escape an unnamed city (possibly related to Crete) and traverse the desert wasteland surrounding the city, to reach The Pixel Empire (Possibly related to Technicolor, and the Palace of Knossos/Tower of the Winds).
- These music videos are likely also a retelling of the myth of Icarus and Daedalus. It is unknown if lore links between Eras, or is repurposed.
- Cover art from Adventure's singles also depicts the Adventure Tower on a small desert island, with a lone figure in the centre. This art may reference the Titaness Asteria's transformation into a small desert island while being pursued by Zeus.
- A shot from the Pay No Mind music video depicts an Eagle emerging from the Tower, this may reference the form Zeus took whilst pursuing Asteria.
- Also featured in these music videos is a labyrinth, likely the labyrinth built by Daedalus (It should be noted that in traditional tellings of this legend, Daedalus is the father of Icarus).
- Icarus and Asteria have been likened to R&K in GFL.
- As mentioned in other sections of this document, Celine was the lover of Prince Endymion who was put in eternal sleep by Zeus.
- The Imperial Lion, used by Imperial Studio, is a reference to the Nemean Lion, who was birthed by Celine in some tellings of Greek Mythology.

Characters

Madeon

- Played by Madeon himself during GFF.
- His involvement in the story prior to the newly added GFF segments is unclear.
- Receives divine power from Borealis, which he uses to clone himself and cause destruction.

'R Girl'

- Has no explicitly mentioned name, is colloquially referred to as 'R Girl'.
- First appeared in rrr.gif on thearchitects.fr
- Also appears in the AMF music video and the <u>Good Faith Announcement</u> <u>video</u>.

- Wears an early version of the Liquid Rainbow Crewneck.
- Theorized connection to R from GFL.
- Speculated to embody a former or current significant other in Hugo's life.

The Imperials

- An organization/people featured within GFL/GFF.
- Imperials wear monochrome outfits with hoods and flat masks that obscure the face.
- Imperials are rarely seen without their masks.
- Dischead is a god to the Imperials.
- Imperials name themselves after letters of the alphabet, but there are some exceptions to this rule. It appears that longer names are a sign of power or divinity.
- Possibly related to Imperial Studio.

R&K

- The two central characters of GFL, although their involvement in GFF's newly added sections is unclear.
- Occasionally referred to as RK.
- First shown during the album rollout ARG in rk.png.
- Rk.png turned out to be a screencap from this <u>teaser video</u> on madeon's instagram.
- Respectively, R refers to the female Imperial and K refers to the male.
- RK also appear on the back of the <u>Good Faith Hoodie</u>, the <u>Daedalus Band Tee</u>, the <u>Good Faith Live Lolla teaser</u>, and various Good Faith Live visuals. []
- The costumes were also present in the LA Pop-up shop [NEED PHOTO]
- Behind the scenes photo of R&K during the filming of Good Faith Live.
- 'RKY' is seen as a phrase on the wall. May allude to a third yet-to-be seen character.

Dischead

- A god within the GFL/GFF canon, supported by their description as <u>"The Good Faith God"</u> in 'The Dischead' NFT
- First appears faintly during NFNM x HMJB in GFL.
- More noticeably appears during Hypermania.
- It is unknown if <u>Dischead</u> is an imperial themself.
- A <u>t-shirt</u> with the same design as the NFT is also available.
- Distinct from Borealis.

F/Borealis/The Queen

- Appears only in GFF.
- The Queen of the Imperials.
- Formerly named 'F'.
- First appears directly in The Prince live edit.
- Wears a crown in the image of Dischead in order to make herself resemble a god
- Possesses divine power (possibly by virtue of the crown) which she grants to Madeon during The Prince.
- According to speculative mathematics, scaling, and the throne schematics, she has a possibility of being 7425ft tall.

Unknown Characters

- A figure facing away from the audience, wearing an Imperial Studio jacket. Appears for a split second at the beginning of The Prince.

Objects

The Imperial Pendants

- First appeared in official Good Faith media during the << M >> interlude in Good Faith Radio 1.
- Meant to resemble the Adventure Chevron or one of its many variants.
- A set of 26, corresponding to the letters of the imperial alphabet.
- Made in 2018 by independent Los Angeles jeweler Takayas.
- Three were exhibited at the <u>pop-up</u>. Speculated to be letters M, K, and R. [2] [3]
- "Some were lost forever, some are yours to find" was listed on their plaque at the Good Faith Popup.
- According to a <u>slip up Hugo made at an Apple Event</u> (51:05), no pendants have been found. The meaning of this is unclear.
- Madeon is seen wearing the M pendant in unused conceptual <u>"dreamdream"</u> cover art, <u>this Instagram post</u> featuring Charly from Chivteam, <u>these photos</u> with the West LA Children's Choir, and <u>during the Grammy's</u>
- Madeon started to wear the pendant for some Good Faith Forever shows in 2021, with photos of him wearing it during Second Sky and in the Madison, New Haven and Nashville shows
- It is theorized that pendants will be a prize for participation in the ARG

-

- Charly has also been seen with one in a social media post (currently lost, may have been deleted).
- Worth \$5,000USD each according to Madeon. Replicas are \$3,500USD in two-tone 14K gold and silver without a gem & \$3,000 USD for a single-tone silver replica also without a gem.
- <u>Inquire here</u> if you wish to commission a replica please send images of replicas to us for documentation. Thus far there have been none made.

Custom Clothing Items

- <u>Imperial Studios Jacket [Front]</u>
 - Called the Imperial Coat in the pop-up shop
 - Was photoshopped in the <u>first billboard</u> so it had the Good Faith logo on the back instead of the lion
 - The <u>Imperial Lion Bomber</u> is based off this item
- Architect Jeans [Back]
 - Called Architect Jeans by Bond when they were accidentally(?) listed on madeon.store
 - References various phrases from Good Faith
 - Displayed at the LA Pop-up shop
 - He wore them at a few Good Faith Live shows
- Daedalus Jacket [Front]
 - Seen in the vinyl cover for Good Faith
 - Displayed at the LA Pop-up Shop
 - Appears in the <u>AMF Music Video</u> alongside the Imperial R Jean Jacket
 - The <u>Daedalus Coach Jacket</u> is based off this item
- Imperial RRR Jean Jacket [2]
 - Not seen too much, only time it's been seen publicly was at <u>B&L Lounge</u> in 2018
 - Has imperial R sewn across the shoulders.
- Imperial R Jean Jacket
 - Has appeared only in the AMF Music Video (worn by someone else) and the Good Faith Announcement Video
- Imperial R Crewneck
 - Has only appeared in the <u>Good Faith Announcement Video</u> alongside the Imperial R Jean Jacket

Good Faith Zine Issue 01

- Originally released in the LA Pop-up shop on the 16th and 17th of November, 2019. Released to the online store shortly after, on the 19th.
- Bundled with a CD copy of Good Faith.
- Focuses on the creation of the album.

- Copies signed by madeon were available in all tour dates starting with the LA shows including Japan (I believe).
- Includes the <u>curvy version of the runes</u>.
- Includes a <u>12122017 BARCODE</u>.
- Includes lyrics to every song in Good Faith.

All My Friends 7" Vinyl

- Released in four cities on the 29th of May 2019
- A 20 record series of 7" 45's of All My Friends
- At four record shops in the cities were Good Faith was written,
- 10 were made with a holographic sticker on the clear packaging and 10 with a white sticker
 - The records are identical, only difference between them is packaging
- 8 were given out as part of the All My Friends Vinyl Hunt
- The remaining 12 are not in circulation

Hypercolor Candle

- Debuted in the Madeon store on the 20th of August 2021.
- Designed by Hugo with the intent of creating a unique sensory experience to accompany Good Faith, associated with scents special to the album.
- Candle is pure soy scented, described as "Earthy".
- The candle is decorated by a holographic sticker with a matte black finish printed over it.
- At the centre of the sticker's design sits the Cursed Chevron (M pendant).
- There are four datamatrix codes on the packaging, and another four on the candle's sticker. Each one is unique.
- On the packaging, the datamatrices decode as follows:
 - Top left: "madeon.store"
 - Top right: "Good Faith"
 - Bottom left: "Just breathe"
 - Bottom right: "I missed you"
- On the candle's sticker, the datamatrices decode as follows:
 - Top left: "Peaceful"
 - Top right: "The Architects"
 - Bottom left: "Same sunrise"
 - Bottom right: "Forever"
- See <u>Datamatrices / QR Codes</u> for more info.

Songs and Music

Dream Dream Dream

- The second single released for Good Faith
- Received a vinyl release.
- The b-side of the vinyl contained an instrumental for the song.
- The ASCAP repertory possesses an alternate entry for the song that lists it as 'dreamdream'.

All My Friends

- The first single released for Good Faith, debuted with the vinyl hunt.
- Received its own music video, see here for more information.
- According to Hugo, it is a song about social anxiety.

Love You Back

- A song scrapped from Good Faith "at the last minute".
- Is mashed up with Beings in Good Faith Live.
- Little is known about the song other than the chorus and drop.
- Hugo loves the chorus, but hasn't been able to figure out the verse
- Working on it alongside other B-Sides.
- Has a strong connection to Happy Humans.
- Madeon played a section of the song publicly during his <u>secret set</u> at the Roxy, showcasing progress in its development.

Be Fine

- The third single released for Good Faith.
- Had a working title of 'Be Fine Again' pre-release.
- Teased by Good Faith Radio, and received a dedicated ARG puzzle.
- Has a strong connection to Happy Humans.

Nirvana

- Debuted at Good Faith Live Lollapalooza, mashed up with Finale.
- Samples Elroy 'Spoonface' Powell.
- Leads directly into Mania.

Mania/Hypermania

- Debuted at Good Faith Live Lollapalooza as Hypermania.

- Released on the album as Mania, without its second drop to align more with Madeon's creative choices.
- The removal of this drop was also a last minute decision.
- Strongly connected to Imperial Studio, and Good Faith Live lore.
- Samples Callie Day in the vocal chops.

Miracle

- Debuted as the outro to Good Faith Live Lollapalooza.
- Was once titled 'America' in the early conceptual phase of the era.
- Is about Hugo moving to America to pursue his dreams of music.
- Received its own music video by director <u>Lena Headey</u>, see <u>here</u> for more information.
- The lyrics heard in the intro to La Lune Live/Instead were originally intended for Miracle, but scrapped.

No Fear No More

- The West Los Angeles Children's Choir can be heard during the chorus.
- Received a remix by Earthgang that was accidentally found early as an unlisted video in a youtube playlist.
- Also received a limited vinyl release with the Earthgang remix on its B-side.
- Four test pressings of the record were also distributed as a prize to commemorate the debut of GFF.
- It is theorized that a mini NFNM Era was planned to tie together the release of the Earthgang remix, with the West Los Angeles Children's Choir scheduled to sing on The Jimmy Fallon Show and the madeon.store banner being changed to 'NFNMerahero.png'. However, many plans never came to fruition as a consequence of COVID-19.

Hold Me Just Because

- Hugo has stated that the voicemail at the end of the song is from someone he loves.
- According to French speakers, the voicemail translates to "You encouraged me to... well, create something."

Heavy With Hoping

- Debuted at the first full Good Faith Live tour showing.
- Sung by Audra Mae, pitched down to sound more androgynous.

Borealis

- An early entry on the ASCAP repertory listed it as 'Borealis (Endlessly)', suggesting an alternate title for the song was planned.
- Written about Hugo's future children.

All My Friends B-Side

- An ARG clue

All My Friends are Asleep

- An improvised arpeggio experiment, according to Hugo.
- An ARG clue found hidden on daedalus.world
- A distorted and heavily processed version of the HMJB voicemail can be heard faintly at the end.

The Prince

- Initially scrapped from Good Faith for being too dark.
- Debuted at Secret Sky 2020 and subsequently released later in the year.
- Received a release on madeon.store with an HD Bundle.
- This bundle contained a variety of high quality logo assets, lyrics, images, an instrumental, and an acapella.
- Kick-started the 12122017 ARG.
- An early logo for the song appears on The Wall.
- An entry on the ASCAP repertory lists it as 'Prince', suggesting an early title for the song.

Symbols

The Imperial Alphabet

- An alphabet created by madeon that's been used both in the Adventure era and Good Faith era to communicate information, easter eggs, and ARG clues.
- First appears in the early 2010s on vinyl sleeve art for Technicolor, The City, and Icarus.
- Saw mild use and made brief appearances during this time, but began to see more use during the Adventure Era, within its music videos and respective ARG.
- There are a set of Imperial numbers, which are written in a braille-esque style, but there is a possibility of a new <u>number system</u>, though that is unclear

- A new variant of the language was used in the Love You Back visuals during Good Faith Live [<u>Transcription</u>], this variant also saw use during the 12122017 ARG.
- A serif (formal) variation of Imperial appeared starting with the <u>UC Riverside</u> and Roxy DJ sets as a visual. As of now, it has not seen any further use.
- On the covers of the singles alongside English in the vinyl covers of the Good Faith singles.
- Each <u>Imperial Pendant</u> corresponds to a character in the imperial alphabet.
- Current official Imperial typefaces with English translation.
- Hugo created Imperial when he was 8 or 9, it used to be more complex with "stacked" characters. The one we know is simplified.
- Possibly appears in the runes (with no apparent pattern).
- Appeared in the popup alongside translated English text.
- Appeared on the <u>second billboard</u>

Imperial Numbers/Mystery Imperial

- Possibly part of the Imperial Alphabet.
- Have not yet been used in an official capacity. Only seen the wall [Closeup] [Remake].
- Theorized to be numbers due to its resemblance to a number pad.
- Characters resembling them have appeared in the runes, but could be coincidental lookalikes.

The Chevron(s)

- A recurring motif and logo that was the main symbol of the Adventure album and surrounding era
- The Good Faith Fra has introduced a number of new chevron variants:
 - Stretched Chevron
 - Four-Sided Chevron
 - Eight-Sided (Stacked) Chevron
 - Cursed Chevron (Imperial pendant design)
- Within the Adventure Era, the symbol was representative of the Tower.

Phrases & Words

RRR/Imperial R

- Heavily recurring symbol across GFL and Good Faith.
- Appeared for the first time in rrr.gif from thearchitects.fr.
- Strongly associated with 'R Girl', who appears in rrr.gif.

- 'R Girl' appears frequently in Good Faith visuals, she wears a <u>Liquid Rainbow</u> <u>Crewneck</u> and always has her back to the camera.
- 'R Girl's relation to R from GFL is currently unclear.
- Good Faith DJ Set visual [2] [3]
- Appear on the Good Faith Pants.
- Also depicted on this jean jacket, mentioned earlier.
- On the back of the merch crewneck.
- On the exclusive Lolla Good Faith Live Shirt
 - _R_ the artist from GFR 5 is <u>not related</u> to the ARG, they are just a person (and a very cool artist)

The Same Sunrise

- Its status as a possible company or entity is currently unconfirmed.
- A lyric in 'All My Friends'.
- The second Good Faith promotional billboard teased its website, thesamesunrise.com
- The website contains a list of words jumbled in alphabetical order:

- This was later <u>Confirmed by Hugo</u> to be the same words as the AMF B-Side:

- "I KEPT IT ... BURIED IN THE GROUND ... FOR YOU TO FIND ... SOMEDAY ... NOT YET ... IT'S GOOD ALONG THE WAY ... JUST TELL ME ... GOOD."
- Also shown during the DDD live edit & other points of Good Faith Live.

Liquid Faith

- A vague concept/idea/phrase within the Good Faith Era, shrouded in mystery.
- Potentially appears in the runes.
- Possibly related to the concept of **LIQUID INERTIA.**
- He "doesn't want to tell us" according to the March 15 Instagram Q&A.
- There are 3 appearances of the phrase on <u>The Wall</u>
- The first, and main, image of Liquid Faith has in the <u>pop-up</u>, <u>his wall</u>, the AMF vinyl hunt video,, and behind him in ironingboard DJ Sets.
- Paper/tape blocked out the phrase in the VINYL HUNT video.
- Primary image in which it features is a photo taken by Hugo's grandfather.
- Hugo in reference to the photo said that "It doesn't look like that anymore."
- Higher quality images reveal a town in the corner of the photo.
- Geolocation efforts speculate the location of the photo to be Goreme Cappadocia, Turkey. Exact coordinates are unknown.
- Was very prominent during Secret Sky and an Instagram Live he did.
- Second appearance of the phrase at the <u>popup</u> showed the words along with several concept names for Good Faith songs. Has *Madeon* written underneath it for unknown reasons. Could indicate that Liquid Faith is a song or project rather than an idea.
- The same paper is <u>covered</u> on the wall.
- The 3rd appearance shows an image labelled "Liquid Faith" alongside 3 other images labeled "Gallery" (one of which being the 12122017 cover). [1] [2]
- Also appears briefly in 'ARPEGGIATED COMPOSITION NO.1' in new Imperial.

Liquid Inertia

- Most likely related to Liquid Faith in some way.
- Shows up as a <u>maxicode</u> in GFL (notably the only appearance of a code/puzzle/easter egg in the show). []
- Appears in a <u>DJ Set visual</u> which has a 12122017 <u>color variant</u>.
 - Same visual also has a variation that says <u>"For You To Find"</u>

We Will Feel Like this Forever / Forever / First Life Forever

- Phrase as it appears in GFL: "WE WILL FEEL LIKE THIS FOREVER THIS IS LIFE IT HAS ALWAYS BEEN LIKE THIS BUT MY EYES ARE OPEN NOW MY HEART IS PUMPING A NEW BLOOD I CAN FEEL IT ALL OVER IT IF MAKES ME BLIND I DONT MIND BECAUSE WHAT I SEE INSTEAD IS BEAUTIFUL"
- May play a larger role in Good Faith Forever.

- May relate to Good Faith's overarching themes of feeling joy.
- "I'll tell myself it'll last forever" (During Miracle GFL).
- <u>Has its own logo</u> which references Dream Dream
- First Life Forever made its first appearance during the UC Riverside set, in the Serif Imperial font.
- Unknown if this is related to Good Faith Forever

THEY ARE REAL

- Appeared for the first time as morse code during GFR01, alongside the M pendant.
- The phrase intertwined with the pendants and Imperials, with differing meaning depending on the lore of Good Faith and Good Faith Live.
- Phrase as it appears on Good Faith Live: "THEY ARE REAL AND BURIED IN THE GROUND FOR YOU TO FIND SOMEDAY NOT YET JUST TELL ME GOOD".
- Phrase as it appears on the AMF B-Side [Holo] [White]: "I KEPT IT/BURIED IN THE GROUND/FOR YOU TO FIND/SOMEDAY/NOT YET/IT'S GOOD ALONG THE WAY/JUST TELL ME/GOOD."
 - The phrase is jumbled on <u>thesamesunrise.com</u>, see <u>The Same Sunrise</u> section of this document for more info.
- May refer to the imperials, the pendants, and possibly Liquid Faith/Liquid Inertia.

MRSL

- First seen on The Wall.
- Possible acronym for something.
- Later seen on the <u>ironingboard sets</u>, in the <u>LA Pop-up</u>, and the <u>Good Faith Vinyl</u>.
- Has a twitter that led to itsarotating.world.
- Referenced in this <u>post by celine12122017</u> where the image is shown in red with the letters missing.
- Part of the letters used to form POMME during the papercraft puzzle.

ARG Chapters

Pre-album release

All major parts of the ARG that happened before the album released

VINYL HUNT

- Started with the <u>VINYL HUNT</u> video being uploaded to YouTube.

- Led to subpages on <u>goodfaith.world</u> with the names of the Four Cities. The subpages had addresses to where the vinyl could be found in the FOUR CITIES

LOS ANGELES: Cosmic Vinyl NEW YORK: Rough Trade NYC

- Hugo's <u>Twitter Moments</u> of the event.

Good Faith Radio

Episode 1: << M >>

Photo has a datamatrix code that scans as 'Letter M', referring to the M on goodfaith.live, where <u>rk.png</u> could be found.

The Morse Code played as the audio track, translated to THEY ARF RFAI

- Episode 2: << BF >>

Teases the 3rd and final single of Good Faith, Be Fine.

The <u>audio track</u>, when slowed down, was revealed to be Madeon saying <u>BE FINE 4 times</u>.

In the original airing of the episode, it said $\leq \leq M >>$ like the first episode. This was fixed for the On Demand version.

- Episode 3: <u>BARCODE</u>

The <u>audio track</u> is widely understood to be an auditive version of the barcode seen in zine one, <u>12122017</u>.

This later turned out to be the explanation for the 12122017 EP included in the back of every copy. What it says can be seen here (outdated picture).

- Episode 4 lacked any ARG hints.

Episode 4 was released to celebrate the release of the album and featured a listening party and a Q&A recorded at the LA Pop-up Shop.

Episode 5: ?

Photo, 2, has some text in Base 64 that translates to "The Prince Will Lead To Celine".

Morse Code translated to '121217'.

It was the first episode to air on a Tuesday instead of a Wednesday like the rest of the episodes, and was also the first episode to have an updated visual style in the cover.

The featured artist, _R_, from this episode <u>is not related</u> to

the ARG.

Be Fine ARG

- Began after Good Faith Radio 2's secret message.
- October 11th IG Post led to Daedalus.world from which BF2.way was found.
- goodfaith.world/BF1, and and https://thesamesunrise.com/BF all hint at BF1.wav filling in the gaps
- goodfaith.live teases the release date of the single.
- <u>dreamx3.com/BF</u> says "NOT YET".
- goodfaith.world/BF1 and https://daedalus.world were updated to link to BF1.wav on October 14.
- https://goodfaith.live also updated to show Be Fine's release date.

12122017

All parts of the ARG that began with The Prince MV and ended with the 12122017 vinyl

The Prince

- A scrapped B-Side from Good Faith
- Song first played at a Yale DJ set in 2018
- First known mention of the song name in a conceptual logo on the wall.
- Later played at Secret Sky 2020, and subsequently released.
- A much darker take on Good Faith.
- Released with an HD bundle of resources related to the song.
- Speculated to represent Prince Endymion, a figure in greek mythology.
 - Prince Endymion was given a choice of destinies by Zeus, of which he chose immortality at the expense of eternal sleep.
 - This could represent Hugo choosing to exclude to song from Good Faith, but immortalising it by releasing it.

The Prince Acapella

- Included in the HD Bundle of The Prince from madeon.store.
- In the spectrogram of the acapella, it had the phrase <u>"The Prince will lead to Celine"</u> in new Imperial.
- Going deeper into the spectrogram, there was a maze hidden inside the Imperial letters. When completed, it traced out the phrase <u>"pulled out of thin heir"</u>.

The Prince Music Video

- Posted by madeon just after midnight PST on August 15, 2020.
- At the start, it has some imperial text that translates to things like

- "A Special Presentation by madeon and The Architects"
- "The Prince will lead to Celine"
- "The Prince by madeon"
- "Find Celine"
- In the description, there is some word art of Hugo in 1's and 0's. The binary on the edges translates to "nonogram".
 - This is the name of the method used to solve the twelvetwelvetwentyseventeen puzzle
- At 1:30, some letters and numbers flash behind madeon. When put into a
 youtube URL, it leads to <u>this YouTube video</u> titled
 "twelvetwelvetwentyseventeen"
- "Twelvetwelvetwentyseventeen" has some imperial in <u>both the new font and</u> the old font that reads PRINCE
- Also has a "barcode" that that is a Pharmacode Two-Track
- In the first frame of the 1212017 video, there's an @ preceding the "barcode".
 - This is a clue to both the twelvetwelvetwentyseventeen instagram and celine 12122017 twitter

Celine

- First mentioned in Good Faith Radio 5 along with 12122017.
- Has a dedicated <u>twitter</u>, found after the release of The Prince, during the 12122017 chapter of the ARG.
- The most active account during the ARG.
- First tweet has a photo of MRSL with the text missing, captioned with "@ x3".
- Warned of upcoming events in advance, such as August 24th at midnight.
- <u>Goddess of The Moon</u> in Greek Mythology (spelling varies from Celine to Selene), notably gave birth to the <u>Nemean Lion</u> in some stories (The figure that the Imperial Lion is based off).
- Celine was also the lover of Prince Endymion through whom she had many children.

Rotating World

- A website with a twitter
- Site that cycles through a series of 8 codes ('00090801', '04201502', '12050504', '15212020', '08051805', '04061518', '15140504', '01250000').
- All of the codes, <u>deciphered</u> through a A1Z26 cipher, read "IHADTOBLEEDOUTTHEREDFORONEDAY".
- The rest don't say anything.
- The code currently displayed on http://itsarotating.world/ was used to reveal a timer on http://stcetihcraeht.fr.

Timer on http://stcetihcraeht.fr/

- When the timer hit 0, it changed to read <u>12:12:20:17</u>. Clicking on it redirected to <u>www.itsarotating.world/12122017/</u> that had street view images from Google..
- Cycles between different images from Google Street View
- Each location with time and coords.
- Nobody needed to go to these locations.
- Updates every 12 minutes for 17 hours with 85 unique locations all within the <u>FOUR CITIES</u>, before looping again.
- Each location, when plotted out on a map spells out 2 letters in imperial

LA: HO
NY: MI
Alesund: CI
Nantes: DE
HOMICIDE

- At 5:38pm PST, celine12122017 posted on twitter an image that says "MONDAY MIDNIGHT PT" in Imperial.

TURBOMEGAFAST

- Found after MONDAY MIDNIGHT PT by Icecube45.
- On MONDAY MIDNIGHT, on <u>stcetihcraeht.fr/</u> the password HOMICIDE became valid.
- Led to a rotating png titled *ELEVENX3* with the script to rotate it called *record*.
- This PNG was made to look like a record, with pixels spiralling around the outside in different colours.
- *ELEVENX3* is a reference to the standard rotations per minute for a 12" record (33rpm).
- "Label" on the record is a darkened photo of Hugo.
- Icecube45 wrote a program that <u>spirals along the "groove"</u> and creates sound according to the color values of each pixel.
- Audio created led to morse code.
- Morse code in the audio translates to TURBOMEGAFAST, background audio is also the same as the <u>12122017 video</u>.
- This led to the Papercraft.

SIXPASSWORDS

- Found after celine12122017 tweeted <u>"SIXPASSWORDS"</u> in the new imperial script.

- A subdomain of <u>stcetihcraeht.fr/</u> with 6 boxes with varying maximum text lengths.
- Top of the page reads Celine
- The 4th field is also already filled in with Celine
- Upon initially finding this, the last two password boxes were unavailable. Passwords:

HFIR

HOMICIDE

TURBOMEGAFAST

CELINE

POMME

ABSOLU

Submitting the passwords results in a <u>new website and a single password</u>.

PAPERCRAFT

- At midnight at the end of thursday August 27, ten PDFs were downloadable by clicking each letter including the space in "GOOD FAITH" inside the phrase "BUILT TO GOODFAITH" at stcetihcraeht.fr/turbomegafast.
- Links: G O O D _ F A I I H
- Each PDF was a papercraft model that would be assembled and placed onto the Good Faith Vinyl gatefold collage like <u>puzzle pieces</u>.
- This resulted in the last two passwords for SIXPASSWORDS.
- On top of the paper models, the <u>dark sections spelled ABSOLU (password 6)</u>
- On five of the models, there were 5 Imperial Neue characters on the bases.
- These characters (ABCDE) locations and their surrounding boxes <u>matched up</u> to text on the vinyl artwork. Resulting in the word "Pomme" (the 5th password).

12122017 Vinyl Record

- Alternatively called 'Celine'.
- A "prize" for the completion of this chapter of the ARG.
- 200 made, sold for \$12.12 through https://12122017.world
- Hugo has called it more of a document than an actual release.
- Was actually made on the 6th of December
- Backside has BARCODE on it, without the distortion but reversed

Loose Ends

This section concerns the state of the ARG post-album rollout and pre-12122017. The album rollout ARG left behind a plethora of loose ends and unsolved mysteries that lead some to believe it was never resolved. Below is a list of loose ends that never seemed to go anywhere, perhaps you can make something of it.

THIS SECTION IS A WORK IN PROGRESS AND INCOMPLETE

AMF B-Side/TSS.com

- The meaning of the B-side is still unclear outside of loose implications.
- tss.com connects to thearchitects.fr, with words from the B-side transcript, as well as a lyric referencing TSS being passwords needed to unlock gifs on ta.fr
- The transcription of the AMF B-Side on tss.com does not progress the ARG in any way (save for two words from the site being passwords to gifs on ta.fr). Additionally, its current meaning is disputed although it is suspected that it links to the pendants somehow.

The Architects Gifs

- Found on thearchitects.fr, there is no known way to find the passwords for most of them (beyond looking into the site's code) and no known purpose for them, if there is one

Imperial Studio

- Unlike the other companies, Imperial Studio currently has no known website. The reason for this is unknown.
- Alongside this factor, Imperial Studio is generally the most mysterious company. Little is known about the role it played in the creation of Good Faith, nor the role they played behind the scenes.
- Additionally, the importance of the word "imperial" raises questions about the significance of this company and its relation to various components of the Good Faith lore. It implies connections to the Imperial font, the Imperial Pendants, and the Imperials of Good Faith Live (despite the live show being a separate canon).

The Runes

Happy Humans & Eternal Eye

- Unlike Imperial Studio, it is unclear whether the likes of Happy Humans and Eternal Eye are companies. They are currently classified as entities because of this.
- Much like Imperial Studio, both lack websites.

Good Faith Live Lore

- Used during the vinyl hunt.
- <u>Teased 12122017</u>.

- Was found in 2018 after the Pixel Empire Podcast, but was inactive at the time.

 - good (ALPHA135ojf.gif)
 - <u>buried</u> (BETA487tcp.gif)

- Thesamesunrise.com provided some of the site's passwords.

- Represents Dreamx3 visual FX.
- Teased Good Faith Era art direction and themes.
- Teased the physical and digital album art.
- Links to a png version of the Good Faith logo
- Text in Imperial translates to:

- Represents Daedalus Production.
- Contains a gif of outwardly cascading clouds in a similar style to thearchitects.fr gifs.
- Hides files via an invisible hyperlink below the gif.
- Has teased the release of both DDD and Be Fine.

- A transcript of the AMF B-side audio, scrambled in alphabetical order.
- Some words are used as passwords on thearchitects.fr.
- Played a role in the Be Fine scavenger hunt.

- Likely represents the Architects.
- Found prematurely by an ARG participant.
- Was initially believed to be a hoax.
- Follows the same layout as thearchitects.fr (including the invisible textbox) but has a reversed and mirrored Architects logo, and darker colour scheme.
- Typing "pulledoutofthinheir" into the textbox will reveal a timer at <u>00:00:00:00</u> (which is <u>red</u> on Firefox and <u>grey</u> everywhere else). After that, input the code currently displayed on <u>itsarotating.world</u>, it revealed a timer that ended on August 21st at 11pm PST (see <u>here</u> for more details)

http://itsarotating.world

- Used during the 12122017 ARG.
- A site that cycles through a series of 8 codes ('00090801', '04201502', '12050504', '15212020', '08051805', '04061518', '15140504', '01250000')
- Decoding the codes in the order in which they appear using A1Z26 cipher reveals the message "I HAD TO BLEED OUT THE RED FOR ONE DAY".
- Name likely references the google streetview puzzle.

https://12122017.world

- 12122017.world is a shopify store through which ARG members could purchase the "Celine" 12122017 Vinyl Record.
- Only 200 pressings were available.
- Only accessible after entering the password "ONEDAYOFANGER"
- The 12122017 Acid Wash Tee was also later sold there.

- Represents Madeon.
- Links to all of his social media, and old sites associated with the Adventure Era.
- Not yet of relevance to the ARG, but contained old art for DDD.

- One stop shop for all current Madeon and Good Faith merchandise.
- Also archives old merch and Good Faith Era artefacts, including the All My Friends vinyl.
- Not to be confused with the merchbar.
