Food Pantries & Nutrition Support



- Indiana County Community Action Program (ICCAP)
 - Manages 17 monthly food pantries, emergency food boxes, PA Senior Food Box Program, Power Pack weekend food for school kids, along with housing assistance and utility support .

 - Weekly community kitchens, formula, groceries .

 - Emergency mortgage (HEMAP), Pathway Shelter in Black Lick (24/7, includes case management), rental assistance, closing-cost grants (Inhabit Indiana) .
- ICCAP Utility & Transport Assistance
 - Energy/utility aid, gas cards, bus passes, vehicle repairs, representative payee services .
- IndiGo Transit & Citizens' Ambulance Service
 - Fixed-route and shared-ride county buses; non-emergency medical transport vans .
