Building Permit Required - Building permits are required for all new construction, additions to, and alterations of homes, manufactured homes, and accessory structures.

A Building Permit Application is required to be completed for all non-structural projects (i.e., roof replacements, window or door replacements, siding, fence installation, etc). Any other project that involves **structural** changes requiring an inspection will need to complete a WI Building Permit Application or Commercial Building Permit Application. Please check with the Municipal Clerk-Treasurer to confirm which applies to you.
