Person, place, thing, attribute, or idea.

Singular vs. Plural

Most just add an s to make plural

student	students
computer	computers
monkey	monkeys
CD	CDs

Some drop the y and add ies when the singular noun ends in y preceded by a consonant.

mystery	mysteries
sky	skies
fly	flies

Add es to singular nouns ending in s, sh, ch, x or z

glass	glasses
match	matches
lash	lashes
fox	foxes
waltz	waltzes

There are always special cases.

mouse	mice
zero	zeroes or zeros
foot	feet
child	children
cactus	cacti
sheep	sheep
thief	thieves
