- \* Shadow Realm: Legendecas, update in last week TC39 meeting -
- □ ShadowRealm FYI Update , Will follow up with suggestion of what APIs should be exposed in Node.js
- \* V8 Michael Z nothing to talk about. Trying to keep canary in good shape, have not had time to update the main branch. Don't believe it will be possible to update again in 22.x as There has been a lot of breaking changes in the public API
  - \* Joyee, V8 announced they will remove support for msvc and move to clang for future versions in Windows. Question is if we can make it for September? Stefan is working it.
  - \* Richard, V8 for windows has always been clang based on msvc was really just "tolerated". One big question is what it means for addons. Really just a 23.x and later issue.

- \* Chengzhong, heads up that MacOS debug build been broken since last v8 update <a href="https://github.com/nodejs/node/issues/53446">https://github.com/nodejs/node/issues/53446</a>. Michael Z, bit of a surprise as I always build with debug enabled. Chengzhong/Michael we get together to figure out.
  - \* Rafael mentioned he had some issues and will share how he fixed it.

- \* Snapshot: they are reproducible again on linux at least in the same container, going to see if it can be backported to older releases.
