

Affiliate Terms & Conditions

Our mission is to provide quality and affordable homeschool curriculum options for families. We want to help families create their unique version of a well-rounded education for their children. We believe that every child deserves access to a quality education, regardless of family income and frequently give out free samples and curriculum to further this mission.

5 Frequently Asked Questions about being an Affiliate

1. What is an affiliate?

- a. In general, an affiliate is someone who earns commissions by sharing our products with others. When you share our products using your unique affiliate link you will receive commissions whenever someone uses your link to purchase one of our products

2. How does affiliate compensation work?

- a. First, our affiliates sign up for their own unique affiliate link. Anytime you receive a sale that comes through that unique link, you are credited at the correct percentage rate for that sale. Our affiliates make a 20% commission on all regular products sold in our shop as well as on our yearly and lifetime memberships. The affiliate rate for bundles and book clubs is 40%. For our subscription clubs the commission is a one time payment when a new customer signs up.

3. How often do affiliates receive payment? Is there a minimum payout amount to receive your first payment?

- a. Payouts are sent within one week of bundles/book club sales ending or on the 15th of each month. There is a \$10 minimum for payouts.

4. What social media platforms do I have to be on to be an affiliate?

- a. We love to have people share wherever it makes sense for them to do so. If you have Facebook, TikTok, or Instagram as your preferred or most active social media, we would love for you to share there. You can also share via email list if that is an option for you!

5. Do I have to be a public account or a private account on Instagram or Facebook to be an affiliate?

- a. No. You are welcome to share on any platform that you would like. It does not have to be public.

6. Do I have to have a minimum amount of followers?

- a. No. We are glad to work with a variety of affiliates.

7. Do I automatically receive free products as an affiliate?

- a. We do not automatically give out free product to affiliates, but we would love to do so! Here's how we do this right now: If you are not receiving a free curriculum from FTLOH and are just sharing our sales and products we do not have a set amount of posts we ask you to post. Just share as often as you

like. No requirements from us. **If you are receiving free access** to our products or clubs, we ask that you post twice about the unit, and at least one of those posts needs to be a main feed post or reel. Be sure to tag us so we can share your perspective on our accounts! We have our main For the Love of Homeschooling account, and our monthly subscriptions each have their own unique account for sharing more about them!

8. How often do I have to post to remain an affiliate?

- a. As the above answer states, if you are receiving a free product, you are required to post about it 2 times, one being a main post or reel. If you are not receiving free products, there is no minimum for posting.

9. What are some of the products and subscriptions within For the Love of Homeschooling?

- a. We have over 1000 products here at For the Love of Homeschooling, from printable products in our shop to our monthly subscription programs like Nature Study Club and World Explorers Club. We also host seasonally themed book clubs and mega bundles!

10. Do I have to create products for FTLoH bundles if I am an affiliate?

- a. No! We provide all of the needed marketing from photos and reels to captions and email scripts, all you have to do is share! We do find that talking about products in stories is a great way to engage your audience and increase your sales/commissions, as is sharing to your email list.
