Residency Exemptions Request

Jacksonville University maintains a [three-year residency requirement](#), meaning all undergraduate students must live in university housing for the first three years of their enrollment at JU or until they have met the requirements to live off-campus. All students that have not satisfied the three-year residency requirement must submit a Housing Application confirming that they will return to on-campus housing each year.

If a student has not satisfied the three-year residency requirement, but wishes to live off campus, the student must request an exemption to the residency requirement by submitting the [Request for Residency Exemption](#) found on the [Residency Requirement Home page](#). An exemption will only be granted if the student meets at least one of the following exemption criteria:

1. The student is at least 22 years old before the first day of classes of the term.
2. You are legally married, as defined by the state of Florida.
3. You are currently serving on active duty in the military.
4. You live with an immediate family member within 30-miles of Jacksonville University, located at 2800 University Blvd. N, Jacksonville FL 32211. An "immediate family member" is a parent, child, legal guardian, or sibling.
5. You are a transfer student at least 3 years removed from high school graduation date.

This form is valid for one academic year and must be re-submitted and approved each academic year the student wishes to utilize the exemption in order for our office records to stay current.

If you are over the age of 23 you do NOT need to fill out this form for residency exemption as you are outside of the standard of the Jacksonville University Live-On Requirement.

Deadline for Residency Exemption Request:

This request does not have a traditional "deadline". A student may submit a [Residency Exemption Request](#) at any point, but there are critical dates related to process timelines and cancellation fees.

For more information regarding the cancellation schedule, refer back to your Residential Life Housing Contract 2025-2026 under the Room Cancellation Policy.

Assignment Cancellation Timeline

Deadlines	Explanation	Fee
On or After May 15th	All continuing students WITH AN ASSIGNMENT that cancel their reservation will be assessed a cancellation fee.	\$200

Room Cancellation Policy: Students will be given a housing assignment if they meet the requirements to live on campus and do not have a completed Fall/Spring housing application or those who cancel their Summer Housing Application after being sent a room assignment.

On or After May 15th, all continuing students with a housing assignment that cancel their reservation will be assessed a cancellation fee of \$200.

The cancellation timeline applies to:

- Students seeking a Residency Exemption Approval after the cancellation date of May 15th
- Students seeking to transfer and cancel after the May 15th deadline
- Students who've met the live-on requirement seeking to cancel their assignment after the May 15th deadline
- Continuing Students that are declared a no show for the Fall or Spring Semester by the Drop/Add deadline

Cancellation Appeal Process:

All students have the right to appeal- the cancellation fee will be applied to the students account ahead of the appeal process and removed if the appeal is granted.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you should direct your appeal in writing within (3) business days of your receipt of the removal notice to the Residential Life Office via housing@ju.edu. It is your responsibility to confirm that the office has received your appeal by the deadline. The Residential Life Office may be contacted via telephone at 904-256-7538, weekdays from 9am-4pm.

Your appeal will be sent to the Appeals Committee and a response will be sent back within 3-5 business days.

GradGuard Renters Insurance

We have partnered with GradGuard, which offers a College Renters Insurance Program that is specifically designed for students. As noted in the housing contract, the institution is not liable for damages or loss that occur to your personal property.

With GradGuard, personal property that is stolen or damaged by a covered cause of loss can be replaced. GradGuard College Renters Insurance also protects you financially in the event you unintentionally start a fire, discharge a sprinkler-head or cause other forms of large-scale, unintentional damage.

Request for Medical Housing Accommodation

Students who would like additional consideration in the housing assignment process or that require specific housing arrangements based on a medical need, must submit the Medical Housing Accommodation Request found on the [Housing Accommodation Homepage](#). This process is for students whose conditions affect them to the point that it can be considered a disability and therefore may need housing accommodation.

NOTE: Students requesting to live with their Emotional Support Animal or Service Animal have a separate documentation process that is detailed in a section below on page 5.

Priority Deadline to Submit: February 28th, 2025

Accommodation requests can be submitted at any time and are reviewed on a rolling basis by committee. However, it is recommended that requests be submitted by the **priority deadline of February 28th** to ensure the greatest chances of receiving an assignment that meets your needs, as there are a limited number of spaces available in each residential building, room type, bathroom type, etc.

Students that submit an accommodation request by the priority deadline and receive approval for their request will be prompted to accept their Medical Accommodation via the Housing Application process prior to the start of the April Housing Application process. The Residential Life Operations team will assign your housing based on your approved Medical Accommodation leading up to the Housing process.

Required Documentation

All requests for Medical Housing Accommodation require documentation outlining the specific need(s) of the student in regard to their housing environment based on the recommendation made by the medical provider assisting with the paperwork. Specific documentation may vary based on the type of accommodation requested. [The documentation provided must provide a clear indication of the medical need or disability and can be found on the Medical Accommodation Website.](#)

Request for Emotional Support or Service Animal

Students that would like to request to live with their service or emotional support animal in the residence hall must submit an ESA Request on the Medical Accommodation Home Page and receive official approval from Residential Life before bringing the animal to campus.

Emotional Support Animals and Service Animals follow a similar process for their on-campus Approval but have different documents that need to be provided. Please connect with housing@ju.edu to request the Service Animal Request paperwork if needed.

Any animal brought into this approval process must be at least 9 months old, potty trained, and up to date on all wellness exams.

Part of the ESA approval process within our office is obtaining a signed Roommate Agreement. This document will need to be signed by everyone living in close quarters with you and your animal. Should one or more of the roommates not agree to having an animal in the space, the Operations Team will assist the requesting student with alternative housing arrangements.

An ESA is only approved for the current academic year, it is not a blanket year to year approval. In order to carry over your approval from year to year, each approved student will need to participate in the ESA Renewal process that occurs each summer.

Gender Inclusive Housing

Residents can select to live in Gender Inclusive Housing and reside with other students regardless of gender similarity or difference by selecting the Gender Inclusive Housing option in the Housing Application. **Gender Inclusive Housing will be hosted in Oak Hall.**

Residents who choose this option will have varied understandings of gender, gender identity and gender expression.

Examples of students who may be interested in Gender Inclusive Housing include, but not limited to:

- Students who identify as transgender or gender non-conforming requesting a roommate based on comfort and support rather than biological sex (i.e., friend or ally);
- Students seeking a mixed gender housing option, including students within the LGBTQIA+ community and allies.

Note that no student will be placed in an all gender room/suite unless the student gives consent to do so.

Fraternity and Sorority Housing

Greek Housing is hosted in Oak Hall on the C/D side of the building. This community is providing lived experiences for growth and camaraderie for their members. These organizations work with ResLife to coordinate semesterly programs to bolster community engagement, and provide social & education opportunities to this community.

Residents living on the Greek Wings will participate in the traditional Housing Application process and if the member is living on the Greek Wing, they will be able to select their room during the Room Selection Lottery. Presidents/Designee's are responsible for ensuring that their members know which rooms to pick during the room selection process if specific people are to live on their Greek Wing.

The Member being assigned to the President's Suite must be submitted to Residential Life by March 24th.

Study Abroad Participants

If you are planning to study abroad fall semester, you must complete the [Residency Exemption Request](#) or notify the housing office via housing@ju.edu

- If you are also requesting to live off campus for the Spring 2026, you'll need to indicate this on the form, as well.
- All students Continuing from study abroad who have not yet met the Jacksonville University Residency Requirement will be expected to return to campus and continue to reside in on-campus housing.

If you are planning to live on campus for Spring 2026, you will need to submit a request to the Housing Office via housing@ju.edu in November 2025

Village Apartments:

- Returning students who have lived on campus for 2 academic years, and are going into their 3rd year are eligible to live in the Village Apartments during the fall and spring semesters if they meet one of the following criteria:
 - Are 21 years of age or older by the first day of the term.
 - Have earned 60 or more credit hours by the first day of the term.

Residential Life: Special Interest Communities

Residential Living and Learning offers unique theme based residential communities for continuing students:

Fraternity & Sorority Life Housing (Oak Hall)

Greek Life Housing is available to Current Students that are active members in Organizations with an assigned Greek Wing. Greek Life communities are located in Oak Hall on the C & D wings on Floors 2-5.

All members living on the Greek Wings will be able to select their rooms during the Room Selection Lottery. The President or Designee is responsible for ensuring the members know which room numbers to pick if there are specific people who should live in the hall.

The Honors LLC is hosted in North Hall and open to students accepted into the JU Honors programs.

This community is multi-generational, with many students living here throughout their time at JU. This community models student engagement through fostering a synergistic relationship between Academics, Residential Wellness, & Community Enrichment. This includes a live-in Faculty Principal and classes offered in the Hall.

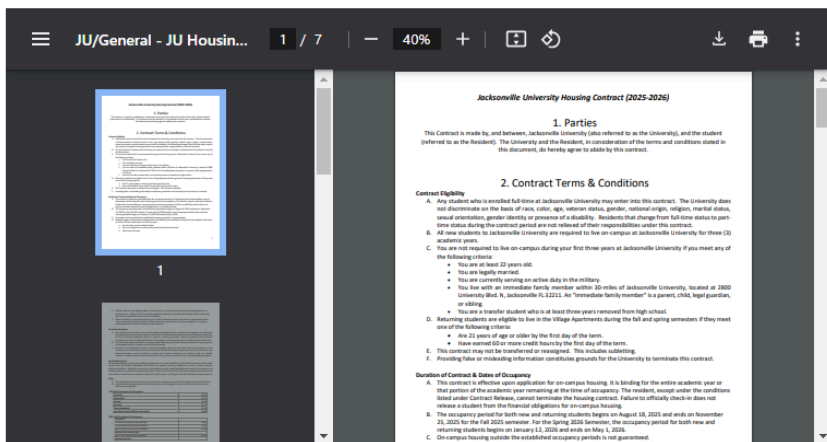

Roommate Groups & Planning

This part of the process can make or break your housing selection- make sure to consider the following when forming your roommate group:

- Where do y'all want to live?
- Does everyone in the group qualify to live in this community?
 - i.e.- If you are trying to live in a Village Apartment, does everyone have 60 credits at the time of the lottery and have they lived on campus for 2 years?
- Who is going to create the group?

<p>Roommate Groups</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Roommate Groups</p> <p>Roommate Groups connect you to other students that you would like to live with. Once connected in a group, you will only see options that meet the criteria of your group! If there are 4 people in your group- you will only see options for 4. If you have 1 person in your group that is not qualified for the apartments- you won't see the apartments.</p> <p>During the Lottery Selection, the person with the lowest number in your group may select housing for the entire group! You can join or leave a roommate group at anytime.</p> <p>We recommend Roommate Groups are used by students who have a previous relationship and trust one another to choose housing together!</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Join a Roommate Group</p> <p>Once you know who you would like to live with, you can create a new Roommate Group or join an existing group.</p> <p>If you are creating a Roommate Group, this means you are the first person in the Housing Portal from your roommate group. You will select a group name and group password. Room Selection Process: Steps:

Please review the information noted below very closely.

SELECTION PRIORITY & The Housing Lottery

1. APPLY. Submit your Continuing Student Application through the Housing Application by the priority deadline April 6th 11:59PM. Failure to complete the first stage of the housing application will default your lottery time to the end on April 11th and you won't be able to join a roommate group.

2. PLAN AHEAD. Think about where and with whom you want to live. Talk to your friends, make plans, and multiple backup plans in case your preferred building or room type is not available when you make your housing selection.

3. FORM YOUR ROOMMATE GROUP. Creating your roommate group in the Housing Application is easy. Remember that all individuals in the roommate group must have completed the first ½ of the Housing Application before being pulled into a group. If not, they will not be able to participate in the Room Selection process until this step is complete.

- Selection priority will be determined by accumulated earned credit hours, future credits for the 2025 Fall term and GPA.
 - Remember that earned credit hours are credits that you have ALREADY accumulated in the previous semester(s) (by January 13th).

Returning Students will be able to go into the Housing Application to select their Housing for the 2025-2026 Academic Year during the lottery from April 8th, 9th, & 10th.

The process runs very similarly whether or not you are in a roommate group. Review the steps below and let us know if you have questions!

Welcome to Your Room Selection!

Below you will find options to make your room selection based on your preferences.

Single: There are a limited number of Single Rooms available. If you do not see this option, they are all full. You may select a room and then continue to check back for open Single spaces.

Single rooms pertain to Current Students only.

Double: Most of our spaces on campus are in double rooms. You can have up to 2 people in your Roommate Group and select a double room. Double rooms are available in Botts, Williams, and North.

Roommate Groups pertain to Current Students only.

Oak Suite: While Oak rooms are double rooms, they are connected to the room next door by a bathroom, making them a "suite". You can have up to 4 people in your Roommate Group and select an Oak Suite. However, as space fills, you may need to drop down to 2 people in your roommate group to select a room (1 side) of an Oak Suite.

Village Apartment: Village Apartments are limited to students who are in their 3rd year- at JU AND have at least 60 credits. The apartments are filled very quickly and largely by seniors. You can have up to 4 people in your Roommate Group and select the Village Apartments.

ADA or Private w/ Bath: These are double rooms in Oak, Botts, or Williams. These rooms are slightly larger and/or may have a private bathroom. These are only available when not needed for Housing Accommodations.

A note about roommate groups: As buildings fill, you may need to leave your roommate group to see space available. For example, if there is 1 space left in Oak but you are in a group with 2 people, you will not see any space available. You would have to leave that group to see the space free. Select "Roommate Groups" above to make changes to your group.
