Pupils share their experiences. Lesson delivery: 1. Teacher asks pupils what events in the neighbourhood contribute to and how do people work together to conduct an event. Pupils discuss and share their answers. 2. Teacher explains how would they contribute if they were to celebrate their neighbourhood sports day 3. In groups, pupils discuss their neighbourhood family day. Teacher explains the activities and how pupils can create a brochure for their event. 4. Teacher shows a sample brochure to pupils and what details should be on every side. 5. Pupils start their brochure while the teacher monitors. Post-lesson: Pupils can share their brochure.
