Thank you for coming in today.

Set the tables up so each of the 6 kids has their own library table parallel to the board. On the back tables place puzzles and a bucket of toy animals.

Read aloud, At our Table by Hulse

Give each child a pencil and the Thanksgiving Counting sheet. (the aides will individually assist each child.) some may want to color. The student then pick books, and go to the back row of tables for free play.

3rd Grade-

Read aloud, Thank you Sarah.

Discuss: Why the author/illustrator chose to include Football in the illustrations? What are your family's Thanksgiving traditions?

After the story the students can check out books. Then do the optional Fall I Spy or read. Students can take their I Spy with them or recycle.

Classes- 1st grade:

Lesson:

Students will sit on their assigned letters in the story corner.

The kids always have to go to the bathroom, so put the boys and girls bathroom pass hanging from the white board in the story corner. Lay out the popsicle sticks for their class on the green table in the story corner. The kids who need to use the bathroom will pick up their popsicle stick and put it on the white board. Then the kids go in order of their names, removing the popsicle stick when they come back and passing the pass to the next student.
