



Example SAPP Budget Submissions

Below are some examples of good budget submissions for SAPP requests. Remember that the more information you provide the committee, the better.

Example #1 - General Submission

Item	Cost	Source
1 Large cookie tray from Tiff's Treats	\$150	SAPP
3 Lemonade pitchers	\$10	SAPP
3 Veggie trays	\$30	SAPP
2 packs of water bottles	\$10	SAPP
Total	\$200	

The club listed a breakdown of each item and the quantity they'd buy of each item and since their club isn't contributing any funds they've listed the source of each item as SAPP.

Example #2 - Club Contributions & Additional Funding

If your club is contributing its own funds or applying for additional funding, it's important to note the breakdown of each source of funding and what items they will be spent on. In the example above they've listed each source of funding, the amount they have applied for or will contribute, and what each funding will be spent on.

Example #3 - Collaboration

For collaborations it's important to note how much each club is contributing and to which specific line items they are responsible for.
