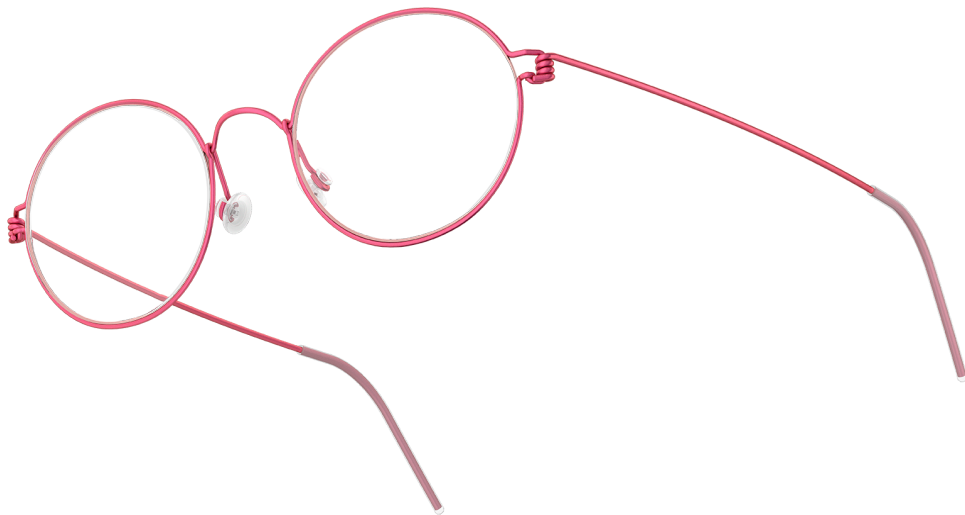
Top 2025 Frame Styles
